



TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE
Bylaw No. 03-2026

A Bylaw to amend BYLAW NO. 13-2011 known as The Operation of Vehicles Bylaw.

The Council of the Town of Pilot Butte enacts as follows:

To Add I. bb) ““Fire hydrant” means a fixture in a street or other public place with a nozzle by which a fire hose may be attached to a water main.”

To Amend III. 3. a. “No person shall, except where authorized by a resolution of Council or when duly authorized by law, erect upon or put any of the following immediately adjacent to any highway, any sign, marker, signal or light or any advertising sign or device.”

To Amend III. 5. e. “No person shall park a vehicle within six (6) metres of any street intersection.”

To Add III. 5. m. “No person shall park any vehicle within one (1) metre from the center of a fire hydrant measured along the roadway, regardless of the hydrant’s distance from the property line or curb.”

To Add III. 5. m. i. “Subsection III. 5. m. withstanding any signage that would otherwise permit parking.”

To Add III. 14. “SPLASHING”

“No person operating a vehicle on a public highway shall:

- a. Splash any pedestrian; or
- b. Project dirt or water at or onto any pedestrian or other vehicle by spinning tires or accelerating quickly.”

To Add III. 15. “CHALK MARKS”

- a. In order to determine the time which a vehicle or recreational vehicle has been parked in a location where parking is restricted to a specific time, any person authorized to enforce this Bylaw may place an erasable chalk mark on the tread base of the tire of the parked or stopped vehicle or recreational vehicle without such person or the Town incurring any liability for doing so.
- b. No person shall remove an erasable chalk mark placed under Subsection a) while the vehicle or recreational vehicle remains parked in the location where it was marked.

To Modify IX. 2. By Removing “along a lot line in any required front yard, not to exceed 1 metre.”
