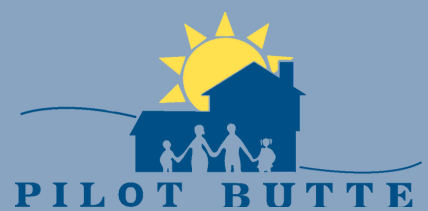

Voyent Alert



The Town of Pilot Butte uses the Voyent Alert! notification system to keep residents informed on day-to-day notices, general information and critical information. Examples of notices sent using this system include but are not limited to town events, road closures, policy or procedure changes which effect residents and local emergency alerts, as well as reminders for collection pick up days (The Town does not use this system for private events or for lost animal notifications). Residents can choose to personalize their preferences to specific topics of interest or all notice notifications and you can receive the notifications by a wide variety of communication channels including mobile apps, text/SMS alerting, email or voice dial. You can register for one or more communication channels.

Garbage, Recycling & Compost



Every household & business is provided with a Garbage cart (grey), Recycle cart (blue) & Compost Cart (green)- optional. Household waste & recycle is collected on alternate THURSDAY mornings, beginning at 7:00 AM. Compost collection is every Monday - April to end of October and the first Monday of the month November to March. Christmas tree recycling drop off will be available after New Year's.

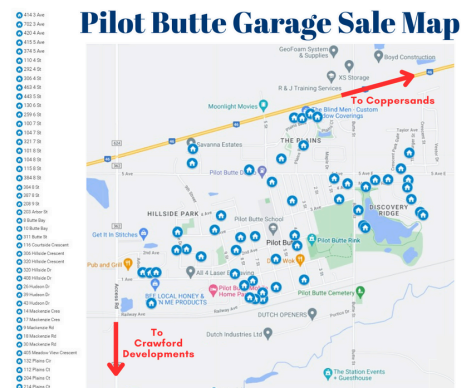
ANNUAL PARADE

General Info for Residents



SPEED LIMIT

The town speed limit is 40km/per hour unless otherwise posted, ie: school zones & playgrounds.

PARKING

For the winter season, residents **MUST** remove trailers and any other item(s) stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards. **Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting November 1st to April 30th of each year.** The Town has to do snow removal and residents co-operation is required to allow for efficient snow removal. Please **DO NOT PARK on the Town boulevards or pavement**, especially after a heavy snowfall. This will assist in quick snow removal and prevent any possible damage to your vehicle(s).

SNOWMOBILES

A snowmobile may **ONLY** travel in town, from the place of residence or place of business to the closest point of exit, and from the closest point of exit to the place of residence or place of business between 8:00am and 10:00pm.

ATV

All ATV's must be registered with the Town. All ATV owners must adhere to Bylaw 3-2021. All ATV owners must carry proof of liability insurance in regards to operating and All Terrain Vehicle in the amount of a minimum of \$200,000.

BUILDING PERMITS

The permit process ensures that minimum safety standards are met to protect you, your family, and your neighbours. It also ensures that construction complies with local building bylaws and zoning regulations. In addition, insurance companies may require proof of the inspection process before insuring any additions or upgrades to your property.

WHEN DO I NEED A PERMIT?

A building permit is required when any structural change or alteration is made to an existing building, or when any new construction is undertaken. Normal building maintenance, such as painting or flooring, does not typically require a building permit; however, separate permits for plumbing, mechanical or electrical work may be required.

If you are planning a residential project that involves structural changes to your home, such as additions or renovations, you will need a building permit. New commercial projects, leaseholds, alterations to an existing building, additions, interior demolition, demolition of a building, or a change of use of a building also require a building permit.

Make sure you understand the building codes and local ordinances before proceeding with any improvement project.

General Info for Residents



PET LICENCES

The Dog and Cat Control Bylaw is available on the website. The bylaw requires pets to be licensed, this will insure that pets who escape can be returned to their owners. The license is \$20 for neutered pets and \$40 for those not neutered; the license being for the lifetime of the pet and not being transferrable to another pet or owner.

Dogs and cats are to be contained on the owner's property. It is against the law to have pets running free outside of your own property. This means that you cannot open the front door and allow your pet out to defecate in the neighbourhood at will. When walking your dog, please hit them on a leash and be prepared to pick up any droppings. Please also collect droppings on a daily basis in your own yard, particularly in the hot weather, so as not to interfere with your neighbour's enjoyment of their own back yard.

Barking disrupts the peace of the neighbourhood. If your dog is new to Town and is left outside while you are away during the day, you may not be aware that they bark frequently. Please try to ensure that your right to have dogs outside on your property does not infringe on your neighbours right to peaceful existence.

Pet license forms are available on the website at this link <https://pilotbutte.ca/pet-licence-registration-form/> though you will have to come down to the Town Office to collect your tags. The tag holds a number only and does not reference either you or your dog by name, phone number or address.

MAILING ADDRESS

You will need to sign up for a post office box, in person at the post office. They will require a document showing your name and the property address on it as proof of ownership, as well as ID verification. Once you have a PO Box, please advise The Town so we can update our records accordingly. Property Taxes



The property tax notices are sent at the end of May and are due December 31st of the year in which the notice is issued. Payments made between June 1st and September 30th may qualify for a discount on the municipal portion- please view your Tax Notice to confirm discount amount and periods. Any amount unpaid by December 31st will be carried forward to the new year and will be subject to a 1.5% penalty on the first of every month thereafter until paid.

You have the option of receiving tax assessment, notices and receipts by e-mail- see the following pages for information on e-Notices/Customer Portal.

You may pay your property taxes in person at the Town office by cash, cheque, debit or Option Pay credit card <https://pilotbutte.ca/local-government/optionpay/> , or you may pay on your online banking as you would any other online bill.

DISCOUNT: Taxes are due by DECEMBER 31st. Online payments can take up to 5 days, so plan accordingly. DISCOUNTS apply to the MUNICIPAL PORTION of the taxes ONLY. An 8% discount applies until June 30th, and a 5% discount applies from July 1st to Sept 30th. Payments must be in our account by the due date to ensure discounts.
 PENALTY: All amounts unpaid after DECEMBER 31st are arrears and subjected to a compound rate of 1.5% per month.

Utility Accounts



Water and Sewer services are provided by the Town and referred to as Utilities. Utilities are billed on the first business day of the month, after the month in which the usage occurred and are due at the end of the billing month. Penalties apply to unpaid bills at 1.5% per month. If unpaid utilities accumulate, homeowners risk having their having their water disconnected and/or having the utility charges added to their property tax account.

You have the option of receiving utility notices by e-mail- see the following page for information on e-Notices/Customer Portal.

The town does not send out utility receipts when payments are received online or by cheque.

You may pay these bills in person at the Town office by cash, cheque, debit or Option Pay credit card <https://pilotbutte.ca/local-government/optionpay/>, or you may pay on your online banking as you would any other online bill:

- Search "Pilot Butte" and choose either the "Town of Pilot Butte", or "Pilot Butte, Town of" as the payee and select Utilities.
- Enter your Account Number as shown on your Utility Notice EXCLUDING the last 4 digits (after the space).
 - If your bank requires a 7- digit number please add 0's to the front of the number until the required number is reached.

We encourage new residents to call into the Town Office when they move to town. Water service is rarely turned off. We will transfer the billing into your name when we receive confirmation of the title change from ISC using the date of official title transfer.

e-Notices/Customer Portal



The Town offers e-Notices as an alternative to mailed notices, and uses a program called the Customer Portal where residents can view current utility and tax notices, as well as previous notices (since your e-notice sign-up date), payment receipts, and current balances! When e-Notices are available, an email is sent notifying you a new document available to view on your Customer Portal. The email will also contain brief details of the notice (for utility notices only- account number, bill amount and current account balance) with a link to the website to view the notice in full.
