2023 Assessment Notices - Mailed March 24, 2023

2023 Assessment Notices will be mailed out starting March 24, 2023. The Assessment Notice is not to be confused with a tax notice (which is mailed/emailed out in May). For 2023, all residents will be receiving an Assessment Notice due to the "Reinspection" done in 2022 by Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency. The reinspection was done physically or via updated documentation returned to SAMA from the resident. SAMA sent a letter to all property owners in April of 2022 explaining the reinspection, and inviting people to report their property details.

Changes you would expect:

- Outbuildings, decks, or renovations previously missed from the assessment may be added to the roll.
- The condition of residential property will be updated compared to the existing SAMA record (general good maintenance vs. disrepair will be recognized).
- Land size, civic addresses, legal land descriptions, can be reviewed and corrected.
- All property reviewed for correctness including commercial property.

Included with your assessment notice will be a blue "**Detailed Property Profile**" of your property. It shows the land size, a residential summary of the improvements on your property along with residential details and your Assessed and Taxable Values. The taxable values are the values used to calculate your tax amount. Please review this document to ensure accuracy. The following is an example of an average taxable value and the tax amount based on 2022 Mill Rates:

300,000 taxable assessment equals \$2,994.90 in taxes - Mill Rates of 5.443 Municipal and 4.54 School

If you want to appeal your assessment, please send your appeal to: Jeannie Devers, Secretary, Board of Revision, c/o Box 253, 222 Diamond Place, Pilot Butte, SK S0G 3Z0. There is a \$75.00 filing fee that will be refunded if your appeal is successful. Assessor Information: Dagmar Crumley, Box 253, Pilot Butte, SK S0G 3Z0.

Please note that a successful appeal is not one where you are appealing because your taxes are too high. An assessment appeal must be based on property valuation; property classification; exemption; preparation or content of the assessment roll; preparation or content of the notice of assessment.

PUBLIC NOTICE**TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE**

Notice of Intent to adopt the Bylaw No. 01-2023 known as the "Town of Pilot Butte Official Community Plan" and Bylaw No. 02-2023 known as the "Town of Pilot Butte Zoning Bylaw".

NOTICE:

The Council of the Town of Pilot Butte hereby gives notice of its intention to adopt an Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw pursuant to The Planning and Development Act, 2007.

REASON:

The **Official Community Plan** (OCP) will help direct and manage growth and development in the Town of Pilot Butte for 15-20 years. This document defines, directs, evaluates, and guides the Council in making development and land-use decisions. The objectives and policies address the future requirements and directions for growth of residential, commercial, industrial, recreational, and municipal land-uses.

The **Zoning Bylaw** is a regulatory document that implements the policies contained in the OCP. This document will divide the Town of Pilot Butte into thirteen (13) zoning districts based on existing and intended future land-uses. The Zoning Bylaw contains regulations and standards including the size, setbacks, and location of lots and buildings, off-street parking, vehicle storage, fencing and landscaping, etc. Each district will contain its own list of permitted uses and discretionary uses, along with general regulations that apply to development in all districts.

AFFECTED LAND:

The proposed OCP and Zoning Bylaw encompass all properties within the Municipality of the Town of Pilot Butte.

PUBLIC INSPECTION:

The document and maps of the OCP and Zoning Bylaw may be viewed at the Town of Pilot Butte located at 222 Diamond Place Pilot Butte SK S0G 3Z0. These documents may be examined by any person without payment of any fee on Monday through Thursday between the hours of 9:00 am – 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm, and on Friday between 9:00 am – 12:00 pm, excluding holidays, up to April 20, 2023 (date of public hearing).

Bylaw documents are available online at <https://pilotbutte.ca/> and hard copies may be obtained from the Town Office at a cost of \$25.00. Any questions about these documents can be directed to the Chief Administrative Officer at cao@pilotbutte.ca or contact 306-781-3409.

REPRESENTATIONS:

The Municipality is open in accepting any written representations from the public that states their concerns or comments regarding the proposed Bylaw No. 01-2023 and Bylaw No. 02-2023. Written representations or any other forms with your full name and civic address shall be submitted no later than April 13, 2023 to the Town Office or email to cao@pilotbutte.ca.


The Council will hear all submissions respecting the proposed OCP and Zoning Bylaw on:

What You Need To Know...

- All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- Golf Carts are *NOT* permitted
- Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are *NOT* permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

- The annual renewal fee is \$15 per plate. You must submit current proof of liability insurance with your payment.
