PROPERTY ASSESSMENT

MAINTENANCE & 2 NEW **HEATERS IN THE RINK**

The rink heaters have recently had maintenance completed, and 2 of the heaters replaced with new ones to improve the heating and comfort for rink visitors! There are timer dials beside the entrances to the stands that visitors can use to turn the heaters on/increase the time.

REVALUATION Every 4 years SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) provides property assessments for Pilot Butte, and all properties in the province. 2025 will be the revaluation year. A SAMA representative will be in Pilot Butte in January/February to complete the assessments. They may visit properties to view the exterior, and request access to the interior for their assessment purposes as required.

The Outdoor Rink

The outdoor rink opened for the season on December 12, 2024. Lights are on daily from 5:30-10pm and the warm-up shack is open weekdays 11am-10pm and on weekends 9am-10pm. The warm up shack is NOT open if the temperature is -25°C or colder. The ice is maintenance is done on weekdays, including flooding on Mondays.

Snow Removal

Snow and Ice Control is completed by the Public Works department following the end of a typical snow event. The Town of Pilot Butte follows a Priority Snow Removal Map in order to plan and prioritize snow removal throughout the Town. Main transportation and emergency vehicle access routes are Priority, shown in purple on the map, as well as School Clearing areas as shown in green. Residential roads are secondary priority. Priorities are subject to change based on circumstances and will be determined by Management.

Sanding/Ice Control

After the grader has completed the snow removal, the roads are sanded with a salt/sand mixture on priority basis following the Priority Snow Removal Map.

Note: The salt loses it's effectiveness once the temperature drops below about -10 $^{\circ}\text{C}.$

A salt/sand mixture available for our residents at the Maintenance Shop on Railway Avenue! Remember to bring your own pail and shovel to obtain this.

Additional Information from the Snow & Ice Control Policy 03-2017:

- Snow and Ice priorities are subject to change based on the circumstances surrounding a particular snowfall at management's discretion.
- Snow and ice placed on municipal streets, sidewalks, pathways or Municipal facilities by individuals or companies is not permitted.
- Snow and Ice Control Operations for residential driveways will allow for a maximum of 24 foot section to be cleared by the Town through the Public Works & Maintenance Department to provide access to a driveway

Tips from the Town:

- Please be cautious and courteous when driving near the grader/snow removal equipment. We ask that you refrain from passing the equipment to keep everyone on the road safe!
- Add driveway markers to your property. This helps our operators effectively navigate the grader and know where the grass and property lines are.
- Please move portable basketball nets away from the street/boulevard.
- Register for <u>VoyentAlert!</u> The Town uses the <u>VoyentAlert</u> notification system to keep residents informed on day-to-day notices, general information and critical information, including snow removal notifications.
