2022 Tax Note

Hybrid Yoga Class

After a skiing injury prevented her from doing mat-based yoga, Kim discovered the benefits of a chair-based yoga practice. The best thing she discovered is that you can use chair yoga in your daily life. Whether you take a few minutes to do some chair yoga at your kitchen table before your morning coffee, or you break up long days of sitting at an office desk with a few poses.

Developed by Lakshmi Voelker-Binder in 1982, LV chair yoga is practiced all over the world and is used by the Mayo Clinic in its wellness programs. As Lakshmi says "get fit where you sit" ". Transform'how you look at fitness and try something new! Chair yoga is for everyBODY!

We have several new Donor Recipients requesting our support with warmth. Our need for yarn and quilting cottons continues.






