

TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE YARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 10-2022

SCOPE OF POLICY:

This policy is effective throughout the entire Town of residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.



INSPECTIONS:

- Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- Untidy and unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate
- If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement officer or delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notification process stated in Section 4: Notification.
- Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in Schedule A: Inspection Dates, which are subject to change annually.
- Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.

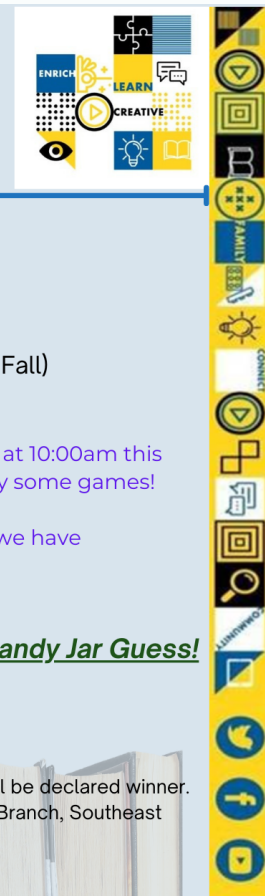

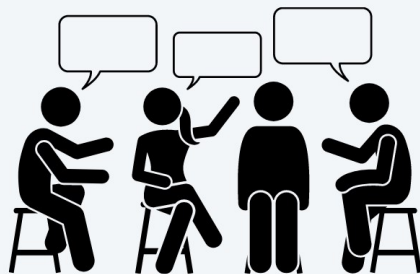

Town of Pilot Butte—Walk A Butte Phase III



The Town of Pilot Butte is excited to announce the successful award of grant funding from the Government of Saskatchewan in support of our "Walk A Butte" project with the installation of two new Pedestrian Crosswalks and two Electronic Speed Indicator Signs along 5th Avenue. The signs will be placed and activated next week. The Town has identified that we would require a multi-functional approach to improve safety and reduce speed along main arteries in and out of town. The support and funding by the Government of Saskatchewan helps our community achieve our goal objectives and provide safe roadways for our residents.

The "Walk A Butte Project" is a multi-year plan that will be phased in over a number of years.

The Town of Pilot Butte will continue to apply for future grant opportunities that support road safety within our community.

Town of Pilot Butte ATV Registration



What You Need To Know...

- All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- Golf Carts are *NOT* permitted
- Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are *NOT* permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

- The annual renewal fee is \$15 per plate. You must submit current proof of liability insurance with your payment.

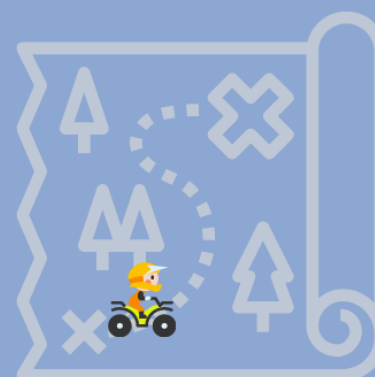

When the wind blows on collection day and some of the carts are in a tangle on the street and you don't know which one is yours...

Here is a solution for you!

Mark your bin with your address on duct tape or gorilla tape. This will ensure you can find your bin (or someone else will for you) and return it to its rightful owner.

Please do not write directly on the bin.

As well, if you make note of the serial numbers of your bins (Compost, Recycling, Garbage) it helps in identifying your bin(s).

Residents are responsible for the bins that are given to them. If your bin is misplaced or lost, you will be responsible for the cost of replacing the bin (\$125.00 as of 2023) and that cost will be added to your utility account.

Please refrain from dumping your grass clippings over the fence into parks and green spaces. Please use your green compost bins for this purpose.

HELP CONTROL THE MOSQUITO POPULATION

Remove sources of standing water on your property by:

- keeping gutters clean
- emptying tire swings
- store items that collect water upside down
- empty rain barrels that are over a week old
- cover garbage, recycling or composting containers to prevent water from gathering

You can also remove breeding sites by:

- repairing leaks from outdoor water pipes, joints or hoses
- getting rid of water that collects in low spots on your property
- keeping your swimming pool cleaned and chlorinated even when not being used
- aerating your ornamental pond, which creates oxygen bubbles in the water
- checking under shrubbery and lawn coverings for hidden containers or pooling water
