

BYLAW NO. 7-2024

THE BUTTE PROTECTION BYLAW

The Butte, or officially named as "Pilot Butte Hill" is now subject to The Butte Protection Bylaw in order to protect and preserve the hill of its natural habitat and history. Please visit our website or the Town Office for more information about the bylaw.

Bylaw 13-2011 Parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles Storage

Attention Residents:

No person shall park a vehicle on a highway or boulevard for any period of time exceeding seventy-two (72) consecutive hours. The 72-hour restriction on the boulevard portion shall be waived from May 1 to October 31 of each year for legally registered vehicles.

The permitted use of the town boulevard will remain available for use during the period between May 1 to October 31. However, please be advised that parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles is not permitted on public land or privately owned undeveloped property.

Yard & Home Construction Materials



It's Summer and you are beautifying your yard, building a deck or renovating your house. Doesn't it feel good to get at those projects? The Town would like to remind residents that the streets and sidewalks are to be shared with pedestrians and traffic. Please ensure that all construction materials are placed and stored in your yard or driveway, and inform your contractor of this before they bring in supplies.

The Town also asks that you dispose of any garbage through the proper means.

Do not dispose of garbage or left over material in parks or public land. This includes grass clippings.

The Town thanks you all for your cooperation and looks forward to seeing your beautiful yards.

Town of Pilot Butte ATV Registration



What You Need To Know...

- All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- Golf Carts are *NOT* permitted
- Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are *NOT* permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

- The annual renewal fee is \$15 per plate. You must submit current proof of liability insurance with your payment.

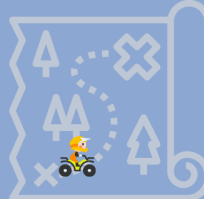

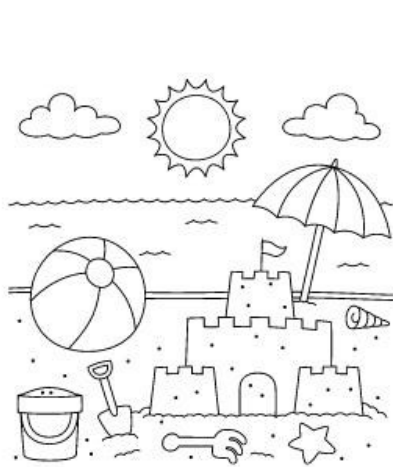

Greenall Girls Flag Football- Ready to make their mark this season!

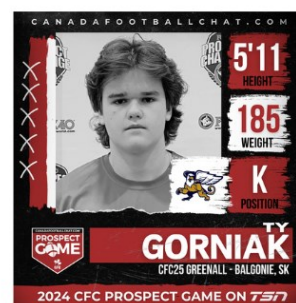

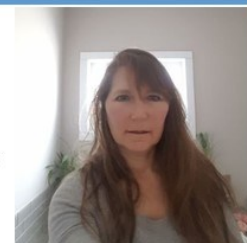

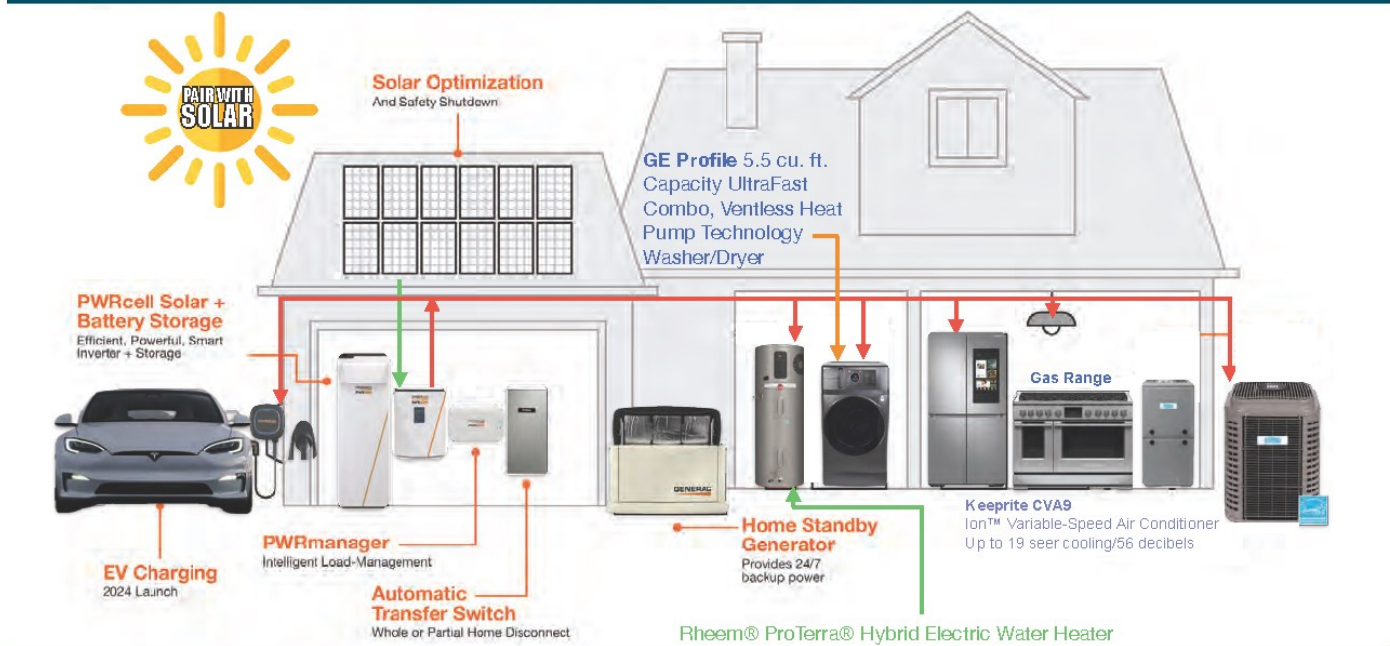
