Did you know?

If your house was built in 2021 the summer of 2024 will represent your last opportunity to take advantage of the Builders Landscape Deposit.

The landscape deposit is refundable within 3 years of the date of the permit approval. This is a minimum landscaping deposit- all of the front, back and side yards must have the bare ground covered with either grass or landscape material to prevent water erosion, blowing sand, or the unsightliness of weeds. No other landscape features are required to qualify for the rebate, though we love to see fences, flowers, trees, bushes, water, boulders and anything else your imagination can provide. The Town appreciates all those residents who take pride in their yards and make them beautiful! Please note that your landscaping may not change the lot levels in any way that will have a negative effect on your neighbours' properties or on public lands.

When you are ready, send pictures of your yard from every perimeter to permits@pilotbutte.ca. I will make an appointment to come out and view the finished yard. Inspections are usually on Thursday afternoons. The Town will send a cheque in the amount of \$1,000 after the Council Meeting next following the inspection providing all requirements are met.

I look forward to a great summer season of lovely yard inspections.

COUNCIL CODE OF ETHICS BY-LAW UPDATE

The Council Code of Ethics by-law No. 02-2024 has been updated. The purpose of this bylaw is to outline basic ethical standards and values for members of council. It is to be used to guide members of council respecting what their obligations are when fulfilling their duties and responsibilities as elected officials. It also explains the procedure for filing a complaint, investigating a complaint, and enforcing these standards and values.

2024 TAX ASSESSMENTS

The Town of Pilot Butte is preparing for the 2024 tax assessments. SAMA (Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency) was recently in Pilot Butte assessing properties that had permits with work completed, or currently have open permits. The 2024 Assessments will only apply and be sent to those applicable properties. The 2024 property tax notices will be sent in May.

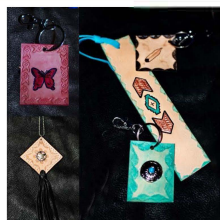

Bylaw 13-2011

Parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles Winter Storage

Attention Residents:

Please be to advise that parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles will no longer be permitted on any portion of the town boulevard for the purpose of winter storage as per Bylaw 13-2011 - Sec. 5 (iv) which states:

No person shall park a vehicle on a highway or boulevard for any period of time exceeding seventy-two (72) consecutive hours. The 72-hour restriction on the boulevard portion shall be waived from May 1 to October 31 of each year for legally registered vehicles.

We understand that over the years, we have allowed for this practice of utilizing the town boulevard in particular those residents that have corner or side boulevards. The permitted use of the town boulevard will remain available for use during the period between May 1 to October 31.

Effective November 1, 2024, any vehicle that exceeds the 72-hours and/or is non-registered shall be fined and/or removed by way of towing/seizure and impounded.

Southeast Regional Library patrons saved a total of \$8.4 Million by using library materials. 80,742 physical items were shipped to other library regions in the province from Southeast Regional Library. 7,274 programs were hosted by public libraries in Southeast with an attendance of 78,853 patrons. Physical items checked out were 69%, and eResources were 31 % of circulation.

LV CHAIR YOGA

In LV chair yoga traditional yoga poses are adapted to be done while seated on a chair. While it might look a little different, the benefits of a session of chair-based yoga are the same as a mat-based yoga session. **LV yoga isn't just stretching on a chair, it is yoga on a chair.** Each chair pose is demonstrated with different levels of flexibility. This means that **LV chair yoga is inclusive and accessible for all.** Regular practice can help improve flexibility, mobility, strength, posture, and balance. Each class will include a warm up, a dynamic sequence of poses, and a mindful cool down.

Kim Kozak will be instructing this course. She has been a certified yoga instructor for 10 years. After a skiing injury prevented her from doing mat-based yoga, Kim discovered the benefits of a chair-based yoga practice. **The best thing she discovered is that you can use chair yoga in your daily life.** Whether you take a few minutes to do some chair yoga at your kitchen table before your morning coffee, or you break up long days of sitting at an office desk with a few poses.

Developed by Lakshmi Voelker-Binder in 1982, LV chair yoga is practiced all over the world and is used by the Mayo Clinic in its wellness programs. As Lakshmi says "get fit where you sit"™. Transform how you look at fitness and try something new! Chair yoga is for everyBODY!

March Update

Greenall Student Honoured with National Award

In May of this year, Kaihl Materi and his dad, cousin, uncle and grandfather were enjoying one of their family hobbies, dirt biking at Barrier Lake. It was during this trip that tragedy struck. Kaihl witnessed his dad clip a rock and fly from his dirt bike into the air and come to a rolling stop on the ground. Kaihl knew instantly that his dad was in trouble. Kaihl and his cousin were first to reach his dad. Kaihl checked to see if his dad was breathing and discovered that he was not. Additionally, he could feel only a faint heart beat. Kaihl began to do compressions and breathing on his dad to attempt to revive him. When his uncle and grandpa arrived they called 911. Kaihl was able to get his dad breathing on his own while they waited for the ambulance. Once the ambulance arrived, STARS was called to the scene. They airlifted Kaihl's dad to the hospital in Saskatoon, to address his life-threatening injuries. Kaihl attributes his quick action to the First-Aid Training he received as a component of the Outdoor School Program he was currently enrolled in at Greenall High School. Thankfully, Kaihl's training and courage kicked in and he was able to deliver life-safe techniques to save his dad. When Mr. Moore, Mrs. Maurer and Mr. Frey, who delivered the First-Aid Training, found out about what Kaihl did, they decided that his heroics should be recognized and nominated him for the Canadian Red Cross "Rescuer Award". The "Rescuer Award" is awarded for demonstrating the Power of Humanity by showing caring and concern for a fellow citizen in an emergency situation and acting decisively to help by applying the skills and training promoted by the Canadian Red Cross. May your actions inspire others in your community and across Canada to respond to others in need. Greenall High School is extremely proud of Kaihl, recipient of the Canadian Red Cross "Rescuer Award".

AT HOME SCIENCE FUN! Make Dancing Popcorn!

YOU WILL NEED:

- Tall Jar or Glass (mason jars work well)
- 1/8-1/4 cup of popping corn
- 2 tbsp of baking soda
- 1 cup of vinegar (use as needed)
- 2 cups of water

- STEP 1. Fill the jar with 2 cups of water to start.
- STEP 2. Add 2 tablespoons of baking soda and stir well to mix thoroughly.
- STEP 3. Add a drop of food coloring (optional).
- STEP 4. Now add the popping corn kernels or popcorn.
- STEP 5. Add the vinegar slowly. The corn will start to "dance" and this may last up to 1/2 hour!

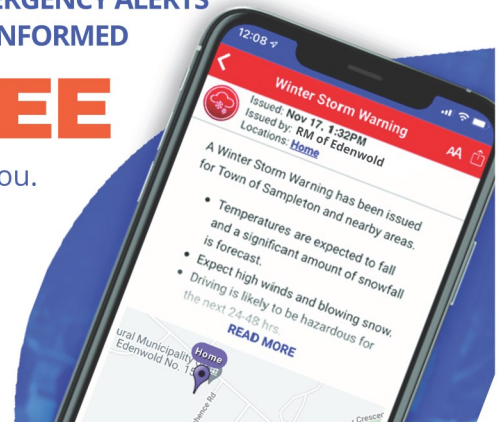
