

- The Town of Pilot Butte is offering one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to any Pilot Butte Grade12 graduating student.

- Scholarship will be awarded upon a copy of an official tuition receipt from the post-secondary institution.

Eligibility

- Preference given to those attending a post-secondary institution in Saskatchewan within one (1) year of graduation.
- Students must be a resident of the Town of Pilot Butte.

Application Requirements

- Submit a well-organized essay, including your contact information (e-mail, address, and phone number). The essay needs to discuss the following:
 - a. Employment history, community and school volunteer work, extra-curricular and school activities. Please describe how your employment, volunteerism, and extra-curricular activities have provided a positive impact to youth leadership in the Town of Pilot Butte.
 - b. What have been the benefits to growing up in rural/small-town Saskatchewan? What opportunities would you suggest that would make the Town of Pilot Butte a better place to live and work?
 - c. A short video on what youth leadership in a small town means to you.
- Submit a copy of your most recent high-school transcript.
- Submit with letter of reference.
- Attend the interview on the pre-determined date.

- Applications due by 1 June 2023
- Interviews will take place on a to-be-determined date.
- When applicants drop off or e-mail in their application forms, they will be assigned a time for an interview, which will be held in the Town Office Council Chambers.

This class is a total body, heart pumping, aerobic and strength conditioning workout. This interval-based class combines full body, high repetition strength training with medium-high intensity cardio bursts designed to tone your body, improve your endurance and clear your mind after a busy day!

Cardio sections include easy-to-follow moves, while strength segments use bodyweight and small equipment to add intensity. This time efficient workout is great for most fitness levels as modifications to all exercises are given and is sure to please both cardio and

Hybrid Yoga Class

This class will combine chair and mat yoga.

Each class will include a warm up, a dynamic sequence of poses, and a mindful cool down.

Our dynamic sequence will begin with yoga poses seated on a chair. Each chair pose will be demonstrated with different levels of flexibility. This means people of all ages and fitness backgrounds can adapt each chair-based posture to suit their fitness needs and goals. Levels of flexibility help ensure postures are practiced safely and effectively on the chair.

While it might look a little different, the benefits of chair-based yoga are the same as mat-based postures. This class will use postures created by Lakshmi Voelker-Binder. Her method, known as LV chair yoga, is practiced all over the world and is used by the Mayo Clinic in its wellness programs.

After we work with chair-based postures, options will be given to transition these postures onto a mat. Participants will choose whether they continue on the chair or move onto their mat based on their own comfort level.



TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE YARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 10-2022

SCOPE OF POLICY:

This policy is effective throughout the entire Town of residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.



INSPECTIONS:

- Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- Untidy and unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate
- If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement officer of delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notification process stated in Section 4: Notification.
- Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in Schedule A: Inspection Dates, which are subject to change annually.
- Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.

NICOLE'S PRESCHOOL



"Why try to explain miracles to children when you can just have them plant a garden." ---Robert Brault

I love this quote. A tiny shoot poking its way out of the soil to grow and blossom into a beautiful flower remains a miracle no matter what our age! There are no words to describe how nature accomplishes this feat...it can only be experienced. At preschool we embraced the arrival of spring by planting little seeds in our indoor vegetable garden and caring for potted flowers. Each child also planted a sunflower seed. They watered and cared for the tiny plants and before they were sent home to grow further in their home gardens they measured and made drawings of their plants development. The look on their faces was priceless as they watched their little "miracles"

We began our exploration of plants with a field trip to the Regina Floral Conservatory in Regina! The Conservatory is filled with plants from around the world from a desert cactus, to a plant that curls up if you touch it to even a pineapple plant! We learned about the function and parts of a plant; how plants need soil, sun and water to grow and we planted a seedling to take home. Back at preschool we dissected real flowers to examine the different parts; counted and sorted various seeds and practiced pouring, scooping and exploring capacity with the lentil sensory box. They were surprised to learn the carrots are really roots, celery is a stem and broccoli is a flower! Until next month---Happy Spring! Mrs. Marshall






