Parking Restrictions in effect as of November 1st

The Town would like to remind residents that from October 31st to April 30th the 72 Hour parking restriction is in effect for Town boulevards.

Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard. Please ensure that campers, boats, trailers, or any other items owned are not stored on the boulevard.

AT NO TIME may vehicles be parked for periods longer than 72 hours on the pavement of any curbed street and may never be parked on the pavement of a street with no curb.
