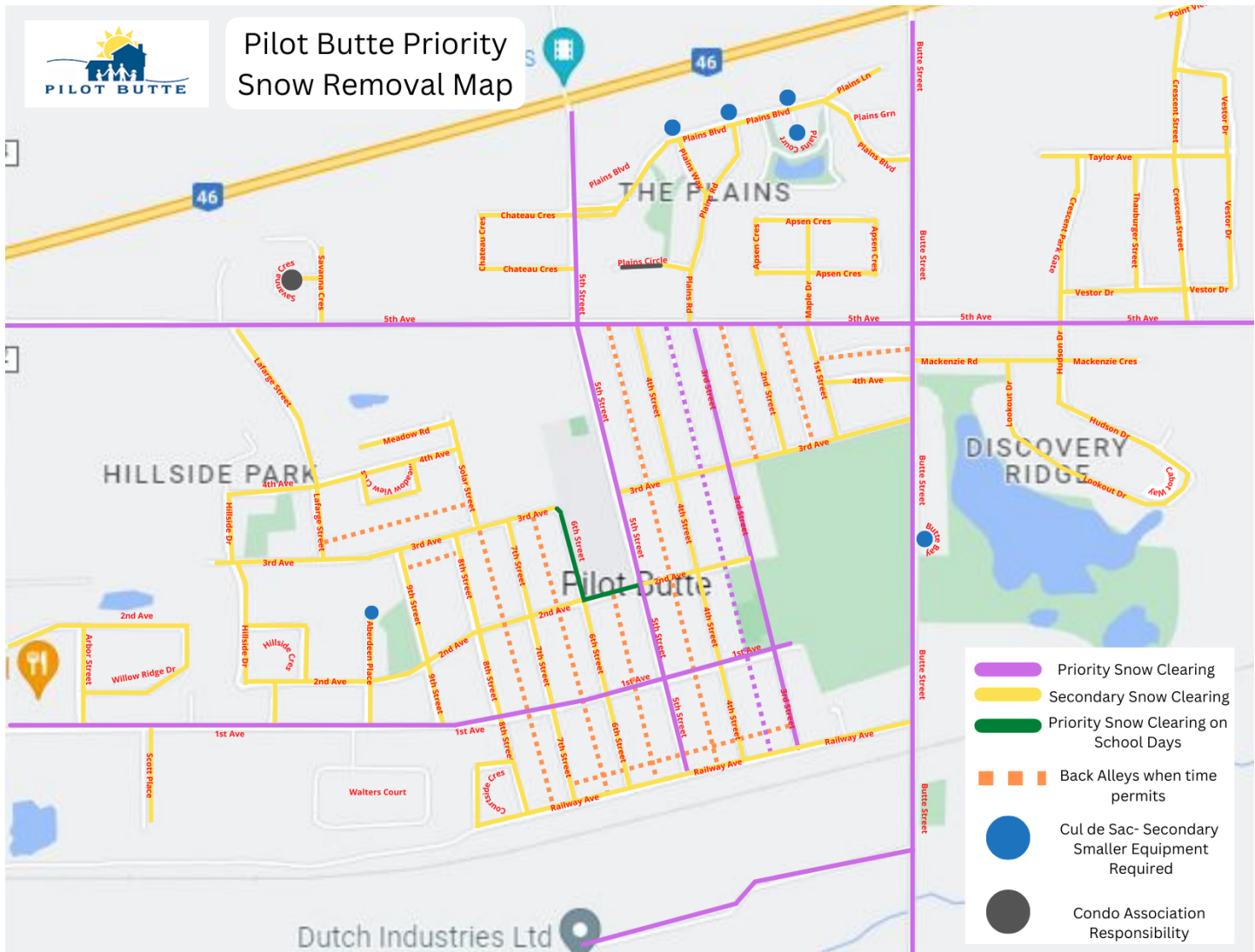

### SNOW EVENTS

Snow removal is prioritized based on the Priority Snow Removal Map, as per Snow & Ice Control Policy- 03-2017. Priorities are subject to change based on circumstances. When possible, please avoid parking on streets so our Public Works can move/remove snow effectively and efficiently.

### COMMERCIAL COMPOST FACILITY

The Town of Pilot Butte and Council continue to oppose the Commercial Compost Facility planned to be built just NW of Pilot Butte off Highway 46. Currently there is no further information from the RM of Edenwold regarding their decision on the discretionary use application. Council is working diligently behind the scenes meeting with ministers and their representations.

### SAND FOR RESIDENTS

The Town has sand available outside of the Maintenance Shop on Railway Avenue for residents of Pilot Butte to take for residential use throughout the winter season to make their driveways/walkways less slippery and safe to access.

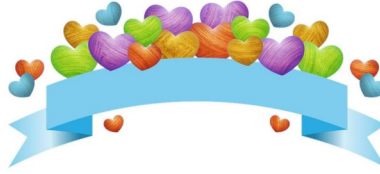

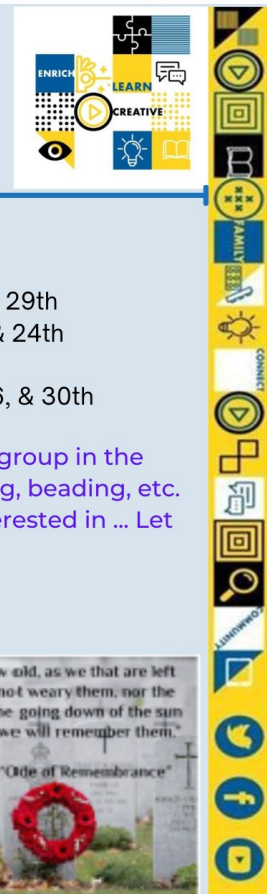

## Parking Restrictions

The Town would like to remind residents that from October 31st to April 30th the 72 Hour parking restriction is in effect for Town boulevards.

Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard, please ensure that campers, boats, trailers, or any other items owned are not stored on the boulevard.

AT NO TIME may vehicles be parked for periods longer than 72 Hours on the pavement of any curbed street and may never be parked on the pavement of a street with no curb.

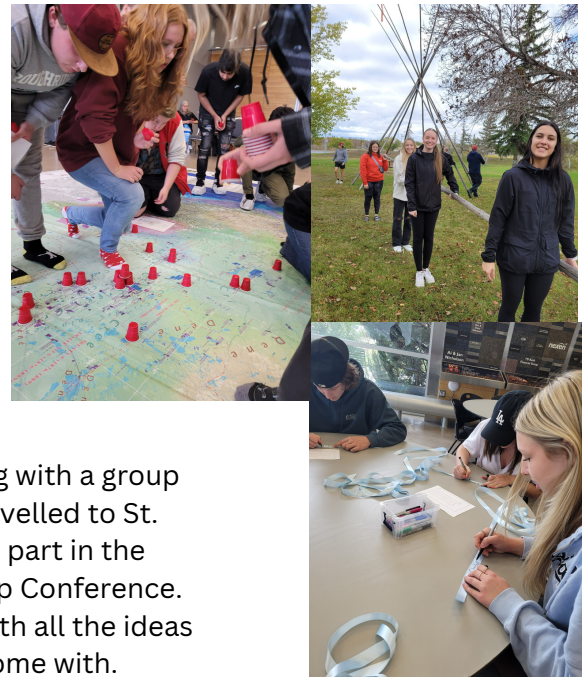
### Law 30
