Parking Restrictions Oct 31st - Apr 30th

The Town would like to remind residents that from October 31st to April 30th the 72 Hour parking restriction is in effect for Town boulevards.

Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard. Please ensure that campers, boats, trailers, or any other items owned are not stored on the boulevard.

AT NO TIME may vehicles be parked for periods longer than 72 hours on the pavement of any curbed street and may never be parked on the pavement of a street with no curb.

Road repairs are scheduled to start on Monday July 29, 2024. Repairs will be done throughout Town as shown on the map above, which can also be found on our website: <https://pilotbutte.ca/uncategorized/road-repairs-starting-on-monday-july-29th/>. Most roads will remain open during repairs, however there may be delays in construction areas. Please plan for a little extra travel time or plan alternate routes to avoid these areas. Below is a list of the construction areas that may experience road closures:

- 2nd Avenue/7th Street
- 4th Avenue/Butte Street

The work is anticipated to complete by mid-end of September.

LV CHAIR YOGA

In LV chair yoga traditional yoga poses are adapted to be done while seated on a chair. While it might look a little different, the benefits of a session of chair-based yoga are the same as a mat-based yoga session. **LV yoga isn't just stretching on a chair, it is yoga on a chair.** Each chair pose is demonstrated with different levels of flexibility. This means that **LV chair yoga is inclusive and accessible for all.** Regular practice can help improve flexibility, mobility, strength, posture, and balance. Each class will include a warm up, a dynamic sequence of poses, and a mindful cool down.

Kim Kozak will be instructing this course. She has been a certified yoga instructor for 10 years. After a skiing injury prevented her from doing mat-based yoga, Kim discovered the benefits of a chair-based yoga practice. **The best thing she discovered is that you can use chair yoga in your daily life.** Whether you take a few minutes to do some chair yoga at your kitchen table before your morning coffee, or you break up long days of sitting at an office desk with a few poses.

Developed by Lakshmi Voelker-Binder in 1982, LV chair yoga is practiced all over the world and is used by the Mayo Clinic in its wellness programs. As Lakshmi says "get fit where you sit". Transform how you look at fitness and try something new! Chair yoga is for everyBODY!
