It's true. After over 40 years of looking out for the residents of Pilot Butte Karen is leaving the Town Office.

We know that residents will want to acknowledge Karen's contributions - over the years she has had a chair on dozens of volunteer boards and has had a huge influence in the shaping of the Town that we know. Her great heart and kind soul, her good common sense and her affinity for numbers, her prodigious memory and her dedication to be the best advocate for the Town that she can be have all made her an invaluable asset and she will be missed.

Karen Byrd was hired as an office assistant starting on May 19, 1982. Karen's career at the Town office sparkles with achievement, including: Karen has been acting in the position of assistant administrator for many years.

In that time she has provided support for a number of administrators as they came and went, always providing knowledge of municipal history, legislative requirements, financial systems and being an excellent researcher.

- Karen is a leader who embraces change. She meets the challenge of new policies and ideas and continues to ensure that Pilot Butte is on the leading edge of innovation.
- When Pilot Butte adopted a water project that took four years to implement and 10 years to pay off, Karen, together with the Project Manager, ensured that the Town had systems to manage the additional office work load.
- In the Community, Karen has volunteered to sit on the Library Board, the Figure Skating Board, the Sustainable Planning Committee, and, mostly singlehandedly, published the monthly Pilot Butte News and Views on her own time over 25 years.

Her favourite people are her devoted (although somewhat quirky) husband, her daughter (best described as a beautiful force of nature) and her grandchildren all of whom live here in town. Water and Sewer Rates

Council passed a bylaw to change the Water and Sewer Rates on June 12, 2023. Council did not make this decision lightly but feels that an increase is necessary to manage current and future Utility assets responsibly.

The water rates have not increased since 2014. Sewer rates were adjusted in 2020.

These rates were approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board, who oversee water and sewer rates for all municipalities.

Residents will see the adjustment on their September utility bills.

Minimum Water Charge as of September 1, 2023 = \$52.00 (from \$47.05)

Minimum Sewer Charge as of September 1, 2023 = \$40.00 (from \$37.00)
