Council meetings are open to the public. Meetings are normally held the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month. If a Statutory Holiday falls on a regularly scheduled Council meeting Monday, the Council meeting will be held on the Tuesday. Unscheduled Special Meetings are advertised in advance for public attendance.

MUNICIPAL ELECTION - NOVEMBER 13, 2024

ROLE OF COUNCIL

Council's main role is to provide leadership and to make policy. Council members collectively make decisions about what services a municipality will provide to its citizens, how services will be provided, and at what level. Council will rely on the support, advice and assistance of administration during the decision-making process. Once decided, administration is responsible for implementing the policies.

WHO CAN RUN?

- Anyone who can confirm, they are over 18, have lived in Saskatchewan since May 13, 2024 (6 months) and have resided in Pilot Butte since August 13, 2024 (3 months) and are a Canadian citizen, and that they are not disqualified by the Local Elections Act, 2015 or any other ACT from holding Municipal Office
- No person is disqualified from being nominated, elected, or holding office as a member of a council by: having an interest in a contract with the municipality or by undertaking the duties of a volunteer firefighter on behalf of the municipality.

WHAT DOES IT ENTAIL?

If elected, you will serve a four-year term. During that time, you should plan to attend the following:

- Meetings of council
- Meetings of council committees
- Meetings of other boards and agencies as a representative of council
- Conferences, seminars, workshops, and conventions for training and discussion
- Events that promote the municipality

Bylaw 13-2011

Parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles Storage

Attention Residents:

No person shall park a vehicle on a highway or boulevard for any period of time exceeding seventy-two (72) consecutive hours. The 72-hour restriction on the boulevard portion shall be waived from May 1 to October 31 of each year for legally registered vehicles.

The permitted use of the town boulevard will remain available for use during the period between May 1 to October 31. However, please be advised that parking of RV, Utility Trailers, Vehicles and Recreational Vehicles is not permitted on public land or privately owned undeveloped property.

MRS. M'S BEST EVER PLAY DOUGH RECIPE! The benefits of using play dough for young children are wonderful and the play possibilities are endless! Here's my favourite recipe! Ingredients:

- 2 cups plain flour (all purpose) - 2 tablespoons vegetable oil - 1/2 cup sait

- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar - Up to 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right) - food colouring (optional) Or 2 pkgs. Unsweetened Kool-Aid Method: - Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a

large mixing bowl - Add food colouring TO the boiling water then into the dry ingredients

- Stir continuously until if becomes a sticky,

- Allow it to cool down then take it out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all of the stickiness has gone. * This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency. * (If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right)
