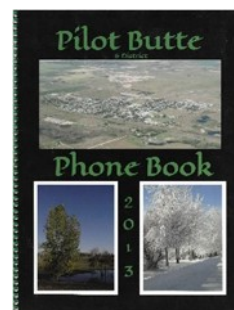

The Pilot Butte Phone Book Committee is once again up and running! We will be creating and publishing a 2018 edition of our local phone book. The last edition was published in 2013 so it is a bit overdue! This is a fundraising effort as well as an informational one. All funds that are raised from advertising and sales go back into the community to fund various projects. The committee starts with the existing phone book and then works with the town who advises the committee of the listed residents who no longer live in Pilot Butte. ## BOULEVARD PARKING

"Winter is Coming, YO HO, YO HO; Winter is coming with ice and snow" – old English folk song

However much we might like to avoid it, winter is coming. That means snow removal. And **THAT** means that, for the winter season, residents must remove trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards. Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting at the end of October. The 72- hour restriction does not mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it every 72 hours. It means that any vehicle not in regular use should not be parked on the boulevard for the winter months. The boulevards are provided to you for your convenience but they are Town property and, for ease of snow removal, the Town requires them to be unobstructed for the winter. **Properties in Violation will be ticketed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Please remember that there is NEVER parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.** The Town thanks you in advance for your cooperation and appreciates your commitment to making Pilot Butte the BEST town in which to live.

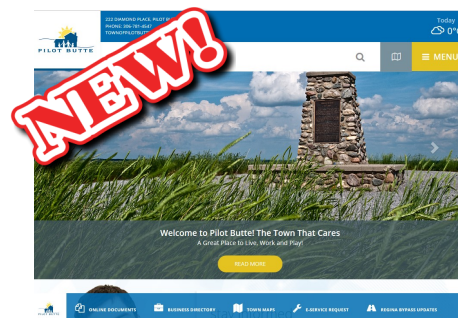

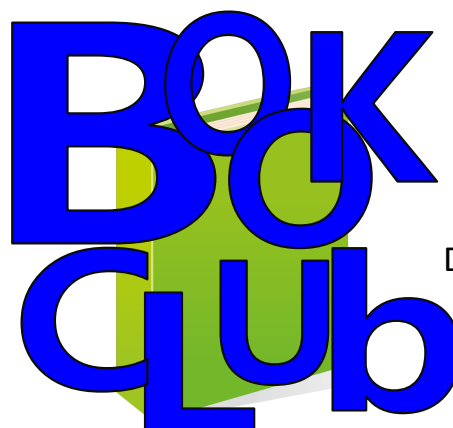

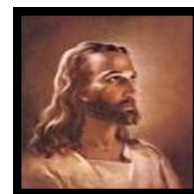

## Pilot Butte and District Lions Club Service Dog Project Update November 2017



Our **Service Dog** goal has been reached!!!!

Congratulations to Pilot Butte Lions members and the community of Pilot Butte. Without the support of individual donations and local businesses we never could have achieved our goal so quickly.

The Pilot Butte and District Lions Club achieved a goal of raising \$12,000.00 allowing our Club to sponsor a Service Dog through Dog Guides of Canada for some deserving individual in our region. There is currently one child from our area on the national Dog Guide wait list. We have specified that this donation be directed toward this White City child who requires and has been approved for an Autism Assistance Dog. We expect that the training process will start as soon as a suitable dog can be found and the family is prepared to move forward. We hope to provide an update as progress is made.

Subsequent to sending our donation, Dog Guides of Canada informed us that we are eligible to receive an additional matching grant that was provided by an anonymous donor. In other words our \$12,000.00 has now become \$24,000.00 and will allow us to sponsor a second dog for some other person. We have directed Dog Guides of Canada to use that money

to supply a Service Dog to the person who is top of their wait list. At this moment we are not sure what type of dog our dollars will be sponsoring but we know there are 400 individuals waiting for Service Dogs on the list.

### **Thanks to all who have donated or helped in any way to make this Lions project a success.**

The demand for Service Dogs continues so we will not stop here and we will continue our fundraising efforts towards the sponsorship of a third dog. We hope we can count on everyone's ongoing support.

Our next fundraising project will be our **"Canadian Country Christmas Dinner and Entertainment"** in the White City Hall on December 2, 2017. Please see advertisement on the previous page in this issue for details. Hope to see you there.
