SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff**. Payment may be refused (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies** and is available by calling **306-781-4547 Option 4**. Thank you.

E-MAIL DELIVERY OF UTILITY AND TAX EBILLS NOW AVAILABLE! NOW EVEN EASIER TO SIGN UP!

The Town of Pilot Butte now offers residents the opportunity to receive municipal notices as attachments in an e-mail rather than by regular mail. The service is a great convenience for those on the go!

If you would like your utility, tax, assessment and/or any other town notices emailed to you, please fill out the **Consent Form and note your account number for your utility and/or tax account. The form now has a check box for convenience.**

In 2017, all residents will receive an assessment notice. This notice will also be emailed if you have submitted an authorization form. If you do not want the assessment notice emailed and you have submitted an authorization form, please email the townofpilotbutte@sasktel.net to have that form sent via regular mail.

You can drop off the completed form at the Town Office or email it back to pbadminassist3@sasktel.net. Thank you. *Forms with the check box not checked will not be acknowledged so please be sure you have filled out the form correctly and checked off the box.* Thank you.

Consent to the use of e-mail for the delivery of municipal notices includes agreement with the following:

- A. Failure to receive an e-mailed municipal notice does not release the resident from their responsibility to pay any charges specified on the notice, or any penalties which may be incurred by late payment;
- B. I will inform the Town of Pilot Butte of any change in my e-mail address as soon as possible, to prevent the misdirection of notices and reduce the risk of my not receiving a notice; and
- C. I may withdraw from e-mail delivery at any time. To do so I will inform the Town of Pilot Butte and all notices which were previously e-mailed to me will be sent by regular mail.

BOULEVARD PARKING

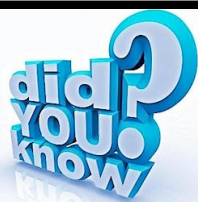
“Winter is Coming, YO HO, YO HO; Winter is coming with ice and snow” – old English folk song

However much we might like to avoid it, winter is coming. That means snow removal. And **THAT** means that, for the winter season, residents must remove trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards. Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting at the end of October. The 72- hour restriction does not mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it every 72 hours. It means that any vehicle not in regular use should not be parked on the boulevard for the winter months. The boulevards are provided to you for your convenience but they are Town property and, for ease of snow removal, the Town requires them to be unobstructed for the winter. ***Properties in Violation will be ticketed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.***

In the event of imminent snowfall, the Town also asks residents and visitors not to park on the pavement where there is a curb. It is much harder to plow the streets effectively when the grader has to navigate around parked vehicles. ***Please remember that there is NEVER parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.***

The Town thanks you in advance for your cooperation and appreciates your commitment to making Pilot Butte the BEST town in which to live.

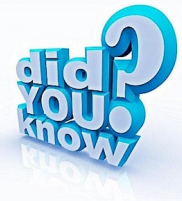
Also, for those who phone the Town Office with complaints, please note that the website contains a complaint form, as all complaints should be presented to the Town in writing.



... Unless posted, the speed limit in Pilot Butte is **40 kmh**. In the **School Zone**, it is **30 kmh**. Please observe these speed limits and keep Pilot Butte safe! Please remember that there is **NEVER** parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.



... That if your garbage or recycling is not picked up, you can call or email the Town Office and we will call Loraas to come back and pick it up? It may not have been picked up for a number of reasons however as long as you put your garbage out by 7 am, it should get picked up! Loraas may not get to it that day but they usually do come back. They have GPS on their routes now that can pinpoint whose cart was or wasn't picked up!



- ... That 2017 is a revaluation year? This means the current assessed value on your land and home will be changing to reflect a base date as of January 1, 2015. All residents will receive an assessment notice in the mail or via email (if you have signed up for this service) with the new assessed value, in February or March of 2017.

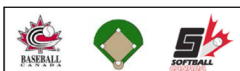

If you are in that group, if you have resolved to get in touch with your spiritual side and to reach out to God in 2017, I hope you will follow through on that resolution - and we'd love to help!

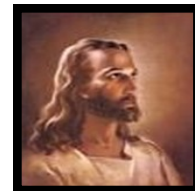
Wherever you are in life, you can count on two things: God loves you with a powerful, unbreakable love; and you are welcome in his church - just the way you are.

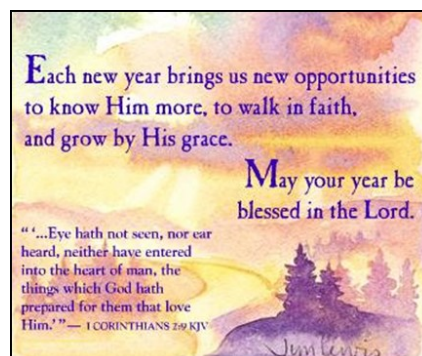

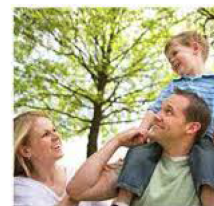

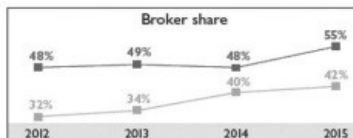
