SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff**. **Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies** and is available by calling **306-781-4547 Option 4**. Thank you.

E-MAIL DELIVERY OF UTILITY AND TAX EBILLS NOW AVAILABLE!

The Town of Pilot Butte now offers residents the opportunity to receive municipal notices as attachments in an e-mail rather than by regular mail. The service is a great convenience for those on the go!

If you would like your utility, tax, assessment and/or any other town notices emailed to you, please fill out the **Consent Form and note your account number for your utility and/or tax account. The form now has a check box for convenience.**

In 2017, all residents will receive an assessment notice. This notice will also be emailed if you have submitted an authorization form. If you do not want the assessment notice emailed and you have submitted an authorization form, please email the townofpilotbutte@sasktel.net to have that form sent via regular mail.

You can drop off the completed form at the Town Office or email it back to pbadminassist3@sasktel.net. Thank you. *Forms with the check box not checked will not be acknowledged so please be sure you have filled out the form correctly and checked off the box.* Thank you.

Consent to the use of e-mail for the delivery of municipal notices includes agreement with the following:

- A. Failure to receive an e-mailed municipal notice does not release the resident from their responsibility to pay any charges specified on the notice, or any penalties which may be incurred by late payment;
- B. I will inform the Town of Pilot Butte of any change in my e-mail address as soon as possible, to prevent the misdirection of notices and reduce the risk of my not receiving a notice; and
- C. I may withdraw from e-mail delivery at any time. To do so I will inform the Town of Pilot Butte and all notices which were previously e-mailed to me will be sent by regular mail.

According to the 2016 Census numbers, Pilot Butte grew by 294 people to a population of 2137. Upon reflection, this number does seem a bit low as the town had 268 new home building permits since the last census.

This is a good reminder to all of us as residents to ensure we fill out the census cards when asked. Grants are based on population so if for some reason a resident doesn't fill out their forms, this equals a reduction in a grant and a potential increase in taxes. So do your part to help us grow and receive the grant dollars we are entitled to by always being counted! Thank you.

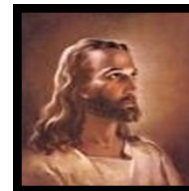

Street Light Outage Reporting:

Sask Power now has an online reporting system for a street light that is out. If you see that a street light is out please go to <http://www.saskpower.com/accounts-and-services/service-requests/report-streetlight-troubles/> and follow their easy to use map tool, as noted.

Once you have reported this outage, you will receive a reference number. Please make note of this number. If the street lamp is not repaired within 2 weeks, please phone the Sask Power service desk, supply your reference number and they should advise when you may expect to have the lamp repaired.

How to Use the Tool

Use the map to locate the streetlight you would like to report. Streetlights are represented by orange light bulbs.

[-] 5 easy steps to report an outage:

1. Find the streetlight near you by clicking on the Locate Me icon or entering an address in the search box (street number street name, city, SK)

2. Select the correct streetlight on the map

3. Click Report this Light

4. Fill out the form

5. Click Report and the streetlight icon will change to

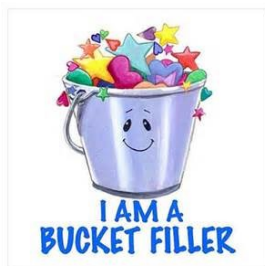

A message from the RM of Edenwold

Growing, growing, growing

February 8, Statistics Canada's Population and Dwelling Counts from the 2016 census revealed the total population of the RM of Edenwold is 4,490. This is an 8.7 percent increase from 2011 census numbers. Of that population, approximately one-third reside in Emerald Park. The RM of Edenwold continues to place in the top 20 most-populated municipalities in the province, this year coming in 19th place. "These numbers show we're a destination for business and residents," says Deputy Reeve Stan Capnerhurst. "The RM is attractive for travellers, daily commuters and those looking for new opportunities while providing a place for ever increasing services and shopping for those residing in the area."

The RM purchased new snow removal equipment in 2016 to add to their arsenal and the benefits to residents is evident. "We have a plan in place to clear as many roadways as we can in priority order," says Derek Hradecki, Manager of Rural Public Works with the RM. "First bus routes so kids get to school on time, then busier arteries and then grid roads." Both Hradecki and Manager of Public Works Wade Hoffman indicate the 2017 year has seen a decrease in complaints to the RM office about snow removal from previous years.

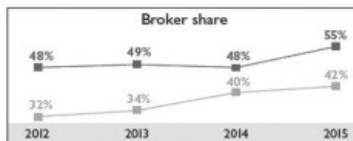
