## Outstanding Utilities

The Town of Pilot Butte sent out letters in January 2017 and registered letters to all residents who had outstanding utilities in excess of \$500.00. All amounts noted in the registered letter were transferred to taxes on March 8, 2017.

The Town has wrestled with how to deal with residents who, for some reason or another, have not paid their utilities in many months. If some residents may have encountered hardships, the town is willing to work with them to reach an agreeable and reasonable payment schedule. This is preferable to the Town instead of leaving the utilities outstanding for a lengthy period of time.

On that topic, the town does have other options available to them to ensure all residents are being treated fairly and equitably. One of the measures that will be taken moving forward is now explained.

Should a utility account be in arrears for a maximum of 60 days

or more (without just cause from the resident), the town may take the unpleasant task of discontinuing service to this property. In the eventuality that this may occur, Bylaw #17-2015 allows for the town to also charge a disconnect and reconnection fee upon service being restored to a property.

The Town has no desire to proceed in this manner however some residents are making it difficult for the town not to consider doing so.

To avoid having your service discontinued, please ensure that you keep your utilities current and ensure that payments are made in a timely fashion. The town prefers to work with a resident to ensure compliance vs following the bylaw to the letter.

All town employees are required to keep any and all financial undertakings between the town and a resident, confidential.



**SEWAGE BLOCKAGE** - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff**. Payment may be refused (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies** and is available by calling **306-781-4547 Option 4**. Thank you.

# Assessment Notices Mailed Out

Property assessment is the process of determining a property's assessed value as of a specific date for property tax purposes.

*Property assessment is NOT the same as property tax.* Local governments use property assessments as a basis for the distribution of property taxes among property owners. For the 2017 revaluation, the Saskatchewan Assessment Agency (SAMA) uses two valuation standards as set out in provincial legislation:

- ◆ A **"Regulated Property Assessment Valuation Standard"** is applied to specified properties (agricultural land, heavy industrial property, resource production equipment, railway roadway, and pipelines) and
- ◆ A **"Market Valuation Standard"** is applied to all other properties (eg. Residential and Commercial).
- ◆ The 2017 revaluation will use January 1, 2015 as the base date.

Your assessment notice shows the new assessed value and the taxable assessment of your property for 2017.

While the assessment has increased that doesn't necessarily mean your taxes will. Council always starts out their budget deliberations with the total taxes collected equal to the previous year collections.

*Please do not call the Town Office at this time asking what your taxes will be for 2017. The mill rates for the Town and the School Division have not been set at this time. The Town cannot nor will not give an estimate of taxes at this time. Once the Town and Provincial budgets have been set, then the town will be able to give "estimates" of taxes to residents.*

If you have questions or concerns about your assessment, please feel free to call our SAMA assessor, Tyler at 306.924.8080. He will be happy to explain your assessment to you. You can also call the Town Office at 306.781.4547 and we will do our best to explain assessment to you!

As noted on the notice, assessment appeals will be accepted until **Wednesday, May 17, 2017**. The appeal must be accompanied by the \$75.00 filing fee (which may be refunded should your appeal be successful).

**Prior to appealing** it is suggested that you please call Tyler @ 306-924-8080 and he may be able to address your concerns.

You can also view your assessment along with other assessments on **SAMAView**.

Go to **sama.sk.ca** and check off the box by "I agree" and then click on the **Map Search** for **SAMAView**.

Once you are on the next page, choose *Pilot Butte-Town* as the municipality, then choose how you would like to search for your property. There are a number of options. Once the search has located your property, you can look at the details by clicking on the "piece of paper" (see below).

Finally, you can click on the map where your property is located and note the assessment for properties that may be similar to your own.

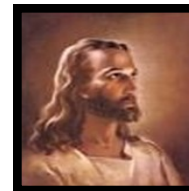

### Street Light Outage Reporting:

Sask Power now has an online reporting system for a street light that is out. If you see that a street light is out please go to <http://www.saskpower.com/accounts-and-services/service-requests/report-streetlight-troubles/> and follow their easy to use map tool, as noted.

Once you have reported this outage, you will receive a reference number. Please make note of this number. If the street lamp is not repaired within 2 weeks, please phone the Sask Power service desk, supply your reference number and they should advise when you may expect to have the lamp repaired.

### How to Use the Tool

Use the map to locate the streetlight you would like to report. Streetlights are represented by orange light bulbs.

1. Find the streetlight near you by clicking on the Locate Me icon or entering an address in the search box (street number street name, city, SK)

2. Select the correct streetlight on the map

3. Click Report this Light

4. Fill out the form

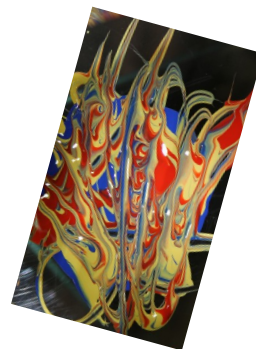



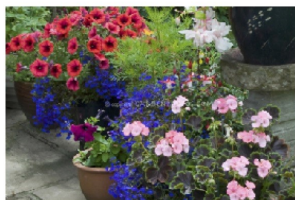

### A message from the RM of Edenwold

#### **Garage suites approved in RM**

Several requests for garage suites have been received by RM staff and Council. A new bylaw will see two bedroom garage suites, with separate entrances allowed in the RM. “It provides a gentle density option,” Senior Municipal Planner with the RM, Jana Jedlic, says. “This housing option creates rental accommodations and allows for nanny suites and room for the in-laws. A parking requirement will have to be met for those wishing to develop these kind of suites.” Garage suites will be allowed in the RM on land zoned AR- Agricultural Resource, CR1- Country Residential (acres subdivided out of a quarter) and CR2- Country Residential (including Stone Pointe Estates, Rock Pointe Estates, Jameson estates, Mission Pointe Estates, Park Meadows Estates, Meadow Ridge Estates, Bridlewood Estates, Crawford Developments, Crawford Estates, and the subdivisions: Bohach, Bilinski, South, Escott and Deneve). Due to lot sizes and accommodation for on-site parking, garage suites are not permitted in Emerald Park. This text amendment has been approved by the RM of Edenwold council and is currently with Community Planning for final approval. Once the RM receives final approval, discretionary use applications can be submitted for garage suites. Visit the RM website for further updates.

#### **Wastewater facility funding announced**

Provincial and federal government funding was announced for the WCRM158 wastewater treatment facility at a special news event February 27. A joint project between the RM of Edenwold and White City, the new facility will be used primarily for RM residents south of Highway 1 - specifically in Emerald Park. Subdivisions north of the highway such as Spruce Creek Estates and Carson Business Park and any future residential and commercial subdivisions will be connected to the facility. An estimated 2,000 current residents, plus several businesses in the vicinity of Highway 1 will be served by the new facility.

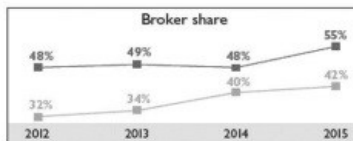

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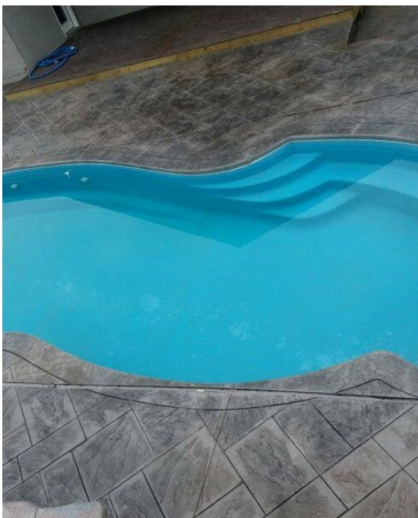

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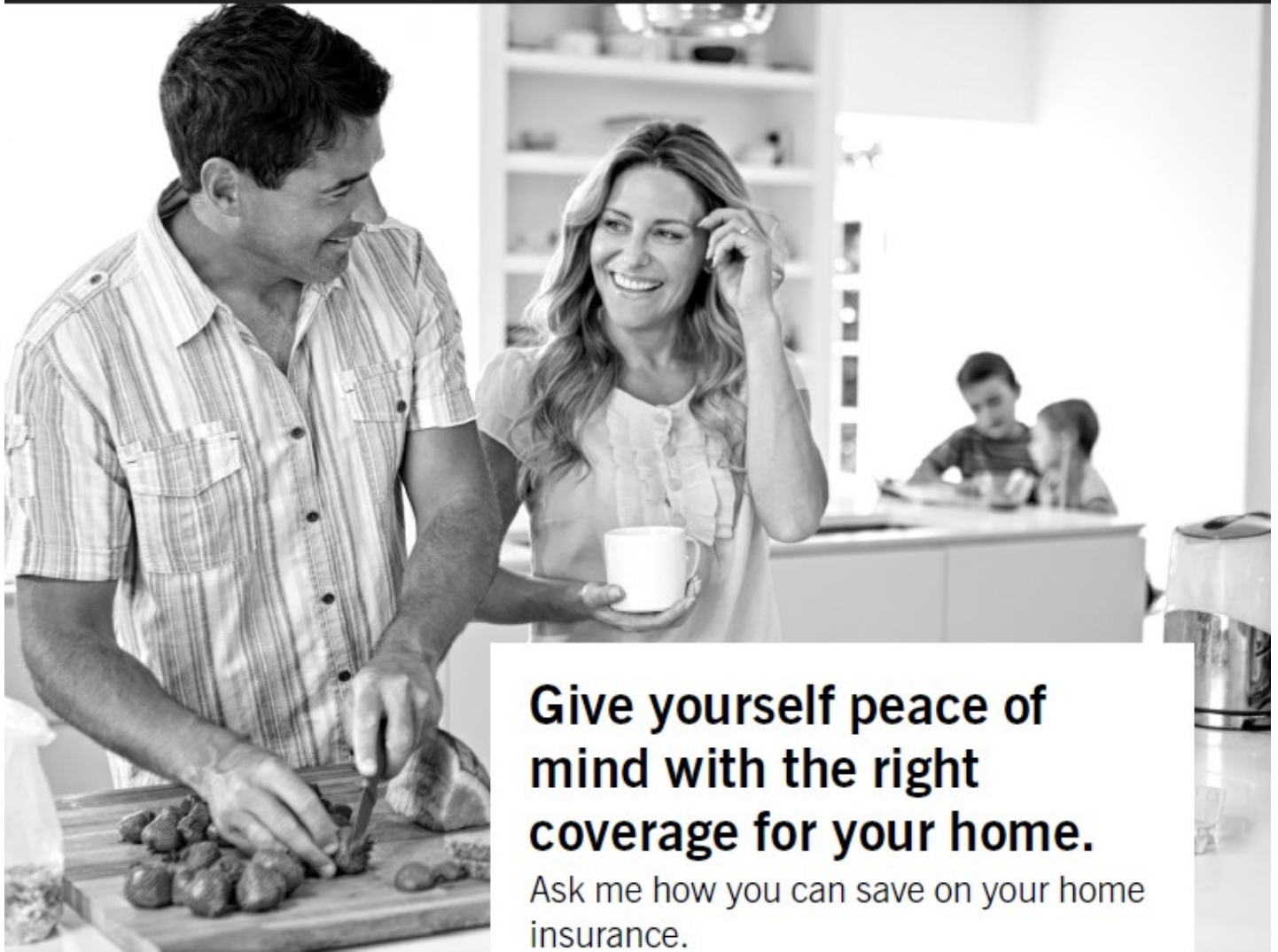
