Water Main Flushing

From May 24th to June 2nd the Town Staff will be flushing the water mains. Flushing is performed to remove sediment from the water mains and to improve the quality of the water in the distribution system. During the flushing, the water from your tap may carry some sediment or be discoloured. This is an expected part of flushing the water mains and can be alleviated by running a cold water tap until the water is clear.

Garbage and Recycling Carts

It's windy so it must be Thursday in Pilot Butte! Shock this past Thursday wasn't!

The last few pickup weeks have been really windy and the wind has been sending carts sailing around the neighbourhood!

Did you know your cart has a number on it and the town records this number with your name and address?

Please take a moment and write down your garbage and recycle cart numbers.

The number on the black garbage cart is stamped in white on the hinged side.

The number on the blue recycle cart is stamped in white on the side where the arm from the truck picks up the cart.

Please record the numbers of both carts on your Garbage/Recycling Calendar for handy reference.

If you don't have a copy of the 2017 G/R Calendar, you can download and print a copy from the town's website @ www.pilotbutte.ca then to Municipal Services—Waste & Recycling and there you will find the calendar and the Single Stream Recycling Guide.

If you do lose one or both of your carts, due to no fault of Loraas or the Town, you will be required to purchase a replacement cart.

Pilot Butte Library Usage Statistics

As you may know, the Saskatchewan Government has made drastic cuts (up to 58%)to libraries across Saskatchewan. The Pilot Butte Library Board thought the residents of Pilot Butte would like to know how well our local library is used.

Based on the size of population that the library services, our usage statistics show that our library is of vital importance to many of our residents. In 2016, there were 92 new patrons who registered with our library!

In 2016, the total circulation of books was 12,216! There were 9602 books checked out which was a 27.9% increase from 2015. The Library was open 25 hours per week and saw attendance of 1425 people in 2016.

It is interesting to note that there are 58% of Pilot Butte residents use the local library

In regards to Social Media posts, there have been 463 "tweets" over the past 5 years. Help us improve our social media presence by following and tweeting the Pilot Butte Library. As far as Facebook posts go, there were 72 posts on the library page. Again, help us increase this by following the Library on Facebook!



"Why try to explain miracles to children when you can just have them plant a garden." --- Robert Brault

I love this quote. A tiny shoot poking its way out of the soil to grow and blossom into a beautiful flower remains a miracle no matter what our age! There are no words to describe how nature accomplishes this feat....it can only be



experienced. At preschool we embraced the arrival of spring by planting little seeds in our indoor vegetable garden and caring for potted flowers. Each child also planted a sunflower seed. They watered and cared for the tiny plants and before they were sent home to grow fur-

ther in their home garden's they measured and made drawings of their plants development. The look on their faces was priceless as they watched their little "miracles" come to life!

We continued our exploration of plants with a visit to the Regina Floral Conservatory in Regina. The Conservatory is filled with plants from around the world from a desert cactus, to a plant that eats bugs and even a pineapple plant! We learned about the function and parts of a plant; how plants need soil, sun and water to grow and we planted a seedling to take home.

Back at preschool we dissected real flowers to examine the different parts; counted and sorted various seeds and practiced pouring, scooping and exploring capacity with the lentil sensory box. Best of all we tasted each part of a plant! They were surprised to learn the carrots are really roots, celery is a stem and broccoli is a flower!

Last but not least a special bunny visited for our annual egg decorating day before the Easter break to deliver a special treat hidden around the classroom for each preschooler to find. And it certainly did not take long for them to find it! LOL
