A NOTE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL MR. WEITZEL

In schools across Prairie Valley School Division we have started our year with the intent of living up to the motto "Be Kind, Because Being Kind is Something Everyone Can Do".

Throughout Greenall High School you will see words and phrases that help to guide our work and learning. "Providing a Caring Climate Conducive to Learning" is our school mission statement and our school values (which will be under construction this year) are: Self-Control, Kindness, Empathy, Respect, Fairness, and written on our walls you will also find the word tolerance, but we are inserting Acceptance as a more welcoming and inclusive word than tolerance as one of our values.

These shouldn't just be words on our walls, these values should direct our learning and work with each other on a daily basis. Living up to these values is essential to ensure we benefit from a positive learning environment which will enable each of our student to maximize their learning potential.

Each of us at Greenall High School holds responsibility for the climate of our school. As we look forward to the year before us, we ask that our entire school community plays an active role in making our school a safer, more enjoyable place to learn by demonstrating respect for yourself and respect for others. We have challenged each of our staff and students to deliberately and consistently be kind and respectful to one another, day in and day out.

It's simple, if kindness towards each other is our primary focus we will all enjoy our time here even more, we will be more likely to learn and we will all be happier, healthier people.

Pilot Butte residents Rob & Jacy Reinhardt are on their way to the Jack Daniels World BBQ Championships in October!

Their BBQ competition team Prairie Smoke & Spice is one of just 3 Canadian teams who received an invitation in 2018. This exclusive invitational contest only has room for 80 teams from around the world, and they truly represent the best of the best. The distillery hosts the contest at their home in Lynchburg, Tennessee.

To qualify for this event, teams need to win a "Grand Championship", at a qualifying BBQ contest in Canada. Rob & Jacy won two of these events in 2018, including the largest BBQ competition in Canada - Porkapalooza in Edmonton, Alberta. Even a championship isn't enough though - there is also a draw process. Since there are a dozen BBQ contests in Canada, each of these champions get a shot at the invitation, which is determined by a random draw.

Rob & Jacy consider this opportunity a very special one - not to be taken for granted. This is actually their 7th invitation in the past 10 years. The event is celebrating their 30th anniversary this year, so there are bound to be some surprises waiting for teams in the "Holler" of Lynchburg. Joining them for the first time in 2018 will be their children - Delaney and Emmett. Rob cooks on Gateway Drum Smokers - using traditional fuels such as Canadian hardwood charcoal and wood.
