BOULEVARD PARKING

"Winter is Coming, YO HO, YO HO; Winter is coming with ice and snow" – old English folk song

However much we might like to avoid it, winter is coming. That means snow removal. And **THAT** means that, for the winter season, residents must remove trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards.

Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting at the end of October.

The 72- hour restriction does not mean that you

drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it every 72 hours. It means that any vehicle not in regular use should not be parked on the boulevard for the winter months.

The boulevards are provided to you for your convenience but they are Town property and, for ease of snow removal, the Town requires them to be unobstructed for the winter.

Properties in Violation will be ticketed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Please remember that there is NEVER parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.

The Town thanks you in advance for your cooperation and appreciates your commitment to making Pilot Butte the BEST town in which to live.



SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff**. Payment may be refused (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies and is available by calling **306-781-4547 Option 4**. Thank you.

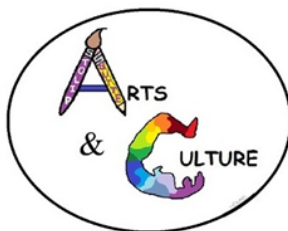



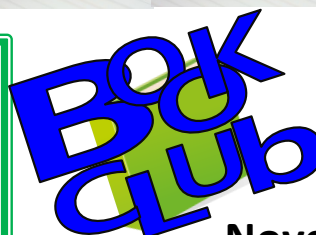

Important Reminders

- The flu vaccine is a safe, effective way to help people stay healthy, prevent illness and save lives.
- Free vaccine offered through public health clinics across the province, some physician and nurse practitioner offices and in local pharmacies. New - pharmacists can vaccinate children 5 years and up.
- Anyone six months and older can receive the flu vaccine and is encouraged to get vaccinated early in the season.
- Getting immunized is especially important for pregnant women, young children, seniors and people with underlying health conditions.

Pilot Butte residents Rob & Jacy Reinhardt are on their way to the Jack Daniels World BBQ Championships this October!

Their BBQ competition team Prairie Smoke & Spice is one of just 3 Canadian teams who received an invitation in 2018. This exclusive invitational contest only has room for 80 teams from around the world, and they truly represent the best of the best. The distillery hosts the contest at their home in Lynchburg, Tennessee.

To qualify for this event, teams need to win a "Grand Championship", at a qualifying BBQ contest in Canada. Rob & Jacy won two of these events in 2018, including the largest BBQ competition in Canada - Porkapalooza in Edmonton, Alberta. Even a championship isn't enough though - there is also a draw process. Since there are a dozen BBQ contests in Canada, each of these champions get a shot at the invitation, which is determined by a random draw.

Rob & Jacy consider this opportunity a very special one - not to be taken for granted. This is actually their 7th invitation in the past 10 years. The event is celebrating their 30th anniversary this year, so there are bound to be some surprises waiting for teams in the "Holler" of Lynchburg. Joining them for the first time in 2018 will be their children - Delaney and Emmett. Rob cooks on Gateway Drum Smokers - using traditional fuels such as Canadian hardwood charcoal and wood.

During the rest of the year, Rob & Jacy operate Prairie Smoke & Spice as a food truck and catering business headquartered right here in Pilot Butte.

A message from the RM of Edenwold

Bylaw court announced

The RM of Edenwold is proud to announce that a bylaw enforcement court has been approved by the Provincial Court of Saskatchewan.

This closes the loop on enforcement of bylaw tickets issued by the Community

Safety Officers. "Our CSOs have been doing a great job with policing in the community protecting our residents and the RM infrastructure," says Kim McIvor, Chief Administrative Officer for the RM of Edenwold. "The bylaw court will ensure enforcement is maintained." Court will be in session the second Friday of each month at the provincial court house in Regina on Smith Street.

Gimme shelter - White Butte Trails news

The RM of Edenwold has partnered with SaskParks at White Butte Trails to provide doors and windows for the new trail shelter. SaskParks maintains the trails during summer, with mowing and other maintenance and the Regina Ski Club maintains cross-country ski trails throughout the winter. "This is a huge asset to have in our community," says RM Senior Planner Jana Jedlic. "We are happy to partner with SaskParks and

enhance an outdoor space that is used for recreation by so many of our residents."

October 4, the final of four public town hall meetings for RM residents concerning the town of White City's annexation proposal was held. "Hosting these meetings was about getting our residents feedback about the proposal and how they would like us to proceed," explains Reeve Mitchell Huber. Residents came with many questions about the town's proposal to the standing-room only events. A website: OurChoice.ca and Facebook page have been launched answering questions residents brought forward at those public town hall meetings.

The RM received a letter from the town (dated: September 14, 2018) requesting meetings re: the annexation. The RM declined, letting them know the RM was still meeting with residents at planned town hall events and that a municipal election was scheduled for the end of October. The RM looks forward to talking about a number of potential changes and options that benefit all residents of the region, now and into the future, and to discuss opportunities for strengthened municipal cooperation.

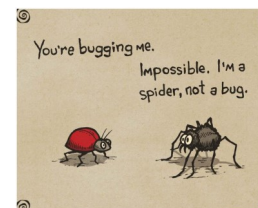
We also made our own "spider webs" by rolling marbles dipped in white paint on black paper, weaving yarn and by using cooked spaghetti dipped in glue on paper plates.
