BOULEVARD PARKING

However much we might like to avoid it, winter is here. That means snow removal. And **THAT** means that, for the winter season, residents must remove trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards.

Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting at the end of October.

The 72- hour restriction does not mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it every 72 hours. It means that any vehicle not in regular use should not be parked on the boulevard for the winter months. The boulevards are provided to you for your convenience but they are Town property and, for ease of snow removal, the Town requires them to be unobstructed for the winter.

Properties in Violation will be ticketed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

Please remember that there is NEVER parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.

The Town thanks you in advance for your cooperation and appreciates your commitment to making Pilot Butte the BEST town in which to live.



SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after**

hours for emergencies and is available by calling 306-781-4547 Option 4. Thank you.



AT HOME RECIPE FUN!

Make Popcorn Lollipops!

Caramel Popcorn Lollipop

1 cup popcorn kernels ⅓ cup brown sugar

⅓ cup butter

⅓ cup light corn syrup

1/3 cup sweetened condensed milk



- Pop the popcorn on medium heat over the stove top. If you want to use microwave popcorn you will need two bags.
- 2. While the popcorn is popping mix the sugar, butter, light corn syrup, and sweetened condensed milk on a small sauce pan over medium heat until it is well incorporated and begins to bubble.
- Put the popcorn in a large bowl and pour the caramel mixture over the popcorn. Mix gently so as to not break the popcorn, making sure that the popcorn gets fully coated with caramel.
- Gently form popcorn balls and push a lollipop stick in the centre.





A message from the RM of Edenwold

RM prepares for March SARM convention
The RM of Edenwold council has passed a resolution to ted at the SARM convention taking place in Regina



.... "We value the work of our local volunteer firefighters," says Councillor Tim Brodt. "We are aware that so call outs they attend to result in those volunteers helping at scenes and witness to incidents which can stay with

them after the trucks have returned to the fire halls. We want to ensure they have the help they need to they can return whole and helped to their families and friends."

If passed by SARM delegates, the resolution would see a one time per-capita levy of 50 cents collected from residents and placed in a fund in trust with the SVFA.

Little Libraries coming to Emerald Park

Free little libraries have been popping up all over North America for some time. The small libraries, nounted on posts in residential areas, are meant to help inspire the community, encourage reading and help to nitiate conversations between neighbours.
