ously. We have been able to venture out to malls, grocery shopping, movies and many other activities which caused anxiety in the past. Floyd is an amazing listener and Peyton is happy to have a friend to talk to. Floyd has also allowed our boys to have additional freedom, as they know Peyton always has a friend with her.

We can never thank you enough for what you have done for our entire family. Without a sponsor such as yourself, this dream may never have been realized. The work you have done is amazing. From the bottom of our hearts, we can not thank you enough.

Mrs. M's Best Ever Play Dough Recipe!

The benefits of using play dough for young children are wonderful and the play possibilities are endless! Here's my favourite recipe!



Ingredients:

2 cups plain flour (all purpose)
2 tablespoons vegetable oil
1/2 cup salt
2 tablespoons cream of tartar
Up to 1.5 cups boiling water (adding in increments until it feels just right)
food colouring (optional) Or 2 pkgs. Unsweetened Kool-Aid

Method:

Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil in a large mixing bowl. Add food colouring TO the boiling water then into the dry ingredients. Stir continuously until it becomes a sticky, combined dough.

Allow it to cool down then take it out of the bowl and knead it vigorously for a couple of minutes until all of the stickiness has gone. * This is the most important part of the process, so keep at it until it's the perfect consistency. *(If it remains a little sticky then add a touch more flour until just right)
