Rides will start at 6:30 PM with the last run starting at 8:30


Maximum 8 people per ride, rides will be 15-20 minutes long

#### WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Yes, that season of snow removal is coming. While we have had a lovely long summer to enjoy our boulevard parking, residents are reminded that, from November 1 to April 30, there is a 72 hour restriction on parking on Town boulevards.

- \*\* The boulevard is the Town-owned land between the edge of the paved street and your property line.
- \*\* On streets with no curb, there is NO allowance for parking on the pavement at any time.
- \*\* On streets with no curb, the boulevard may be used for parking of vehicles in daily use. The 72 hour restriction doesn't mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it. It means that you cannot store vehicles on the boulevard during the winter months.

  The same thing applies to payed streets where there is a curb
- The same thing applies to paved streets where there is a curb.

  \*\* On any street, whether there is or is not a curb, the Town.
- \*\* On any street, whether there is or is not a curb, the Town appreciates that vehicles will not be parked either on the boulevard or on the pavement when snowfall is imminent. When operators are cleaning the streets, particularly after heavy snowfall, that snow has to go somewhere. The boulevards serve that purpose.

The Town thanks all those residents who help us out by complying with the law. Please be asssured that vehicles which are left on boulevards or on streets may be ticketed and /or towed.





**SEWAGE BLOCKAGE** - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Town Maintenance Director) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after hours for** 

emergencies and is available by calling 306-781-4547 Option 7. Thank you.





We also crashed tennis ball "meteors"


into sand to make our own craters and made a Venus "volcano" with baking soda, vinegar, liquid soap and a pop bottle!

### Prekindergarten Program Availability

We have one opening in our Prek program at Pilot Butte School starting on January 6, 2020. The Prek program is a ministry-funded program, and as such, they have developed criteria to determine eligibility. For the purpose of Prekindergarten, the Ministry of Education defines vulnerability broadly, prioritizing and giving preference to applicants with:

- low socio-economic status;
- referral from a government or community-based agency;
- social isolation or not having access to early learning programs or child care;
- family health care challenges;
- exposure to family trauma; and/or,
- delays in areas such as social-emotional, language and/or communication development.


If you have a child who is 3 or 4 years old and you feel would be a candidate for our program, please contact the school for an application.




