Go Out and Play Challenge

Pilot Butte has registered for the Go Out and Play Challenge put on by Saskatchewan In Motion and Saskatchewan Blue Cross. The Go Out and Play Challenge asks registered communities to track their physical activity minutes for 10 days in March. Pilot Butte registered early earning 1,000 physical activity minutes. Should we win, the money will go toward developing a Spray Park.

You can now create an online profile for tracking your physical activity minutes. Individual profiles can be made for anyone over the age of 13. Must be 13 at the start of the challenge. Anyone under the age of 13 must be included in a Family profile. Families are encouraged to include grandparents as well to a maximum of four (4).

Participants do not have to be residents of Saskatchewan or of Pilot Butte.

Go Out and Play dates are March 1st to 10th. Each individual or family member can enter up to 120 minutes each day. Physical activity

minutes can be done at home, school, or in the community. A simple 10 minute dog walk, walking to school, or participating in public skating can count toward the 120 minutes. You are responsible for entering your minutes. Minutes are to be entered each day.

You **cannot** go back and enter missed physical activity

minutes from previous days. Schools cannot enter minutes for their students, this must be done at home.



BOULEVARD PARKING

However much we might like to avoid it, winter is here!

That means snow removal. And **THAT** means that, for the winter season, residents must remove trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked on the boulevards.

Vehicles that are being used every day may be parked on the boulevards for periods no longer than 72 hours starting at the end of October.

The 72- hour restriction does not mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it every 72

hours. It means that any vehicle not in regular use should not be parked on the boulevard for the winter months. The boulevards are provided to you for your convenience but they are Town property and, for ease of snow removal, the Town requires them to be unobstructed for the winter.

Properties in Violation will be ticketed by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Please remember that there is NEVER parking allowed on the travelled portion of the road where no curb exists.

The Town thanks you in advance for your cooperation and appreciates your commitment to making Pilot Butte the BEST town in which to live.



SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Director of Public Works & Maintenance Operations) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after**

hours for emergencies and is available by calling 306-781-4547 Option 4. Thank you.




