The Rodeo committee wishes to thank everyone who in any way contributed to the success of the Rodeo event this year, our 27th year.

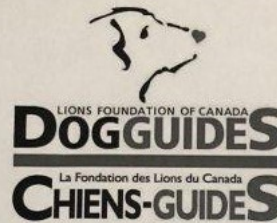

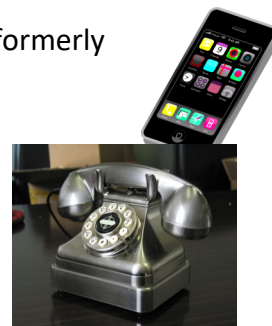

***"Bylaw No. 11-2017 - A Bylaw to License and Regulate Dogs Running at Large; Dog & Cat Control - Ownership and Possession"***

Please note the town has made available for your use, stations with baggies for dog owners to clean up after their pets.

### **Parking**

***Bylaw No.13-2011 - A Bylaw to Regulate the Operation of Vehicles***

Winter parking restriction still apply. In regard to parking on Town

streets and boulevards, residents are asked to please note the following:

Parking on Boulevards is restricted to 72 hours until April 30. This means that only vehicles in regular use may be parked there. There is no provision for storing vehicles, trailers, boats or anything else on Town boulevards for the duration of the winter.

For the summer months, from May 1<sup>st</sup> until October 30<sup>th</sup>, there are no restrictions on boulevard parking except for the following:

- A) No large recreation vehicles may block sight lines, causing visibility issues for drivers or bicycles.
- B) No unlicensed or junked vehicles may be parked on Town boulevards (or anywhere outside of a fence or garage)

Parking on the paved, travelled part of streets without curbs is never allowed.

Parking on streets with curbs is allowed, but again, the Town appreciates that you will not use street parking for storage of boats, trailers or campers. *Thank you for your cooperation.*

**SEWAGE BLOCKAGE** - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST** be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused (at the discretion of the Town Maintenance Director) if this condition is not met. A maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies and is available by calling **306-781-4547 Option 7**. Thank you.

### **School's Out Day Camp**

School's Out Day Camp is back again. SODC is a one-day, registered camp on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

School's Out Day Camps will feature Early Drop Off and Late Pick Up Service this year. Early Drop Off will run from 7:30 am to 8:55 am, Late Pick Up will run from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. This is a registered service at an additional cost. Regular camp hours are 9:00am to 4:00pm in the Pilot Butte Community Hall. SODC **without** Early Drop Off and Late Pick Up is \$20.

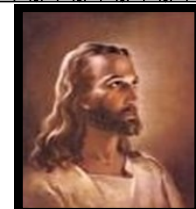

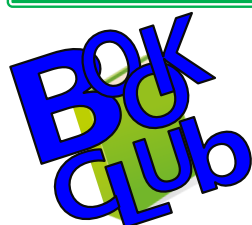

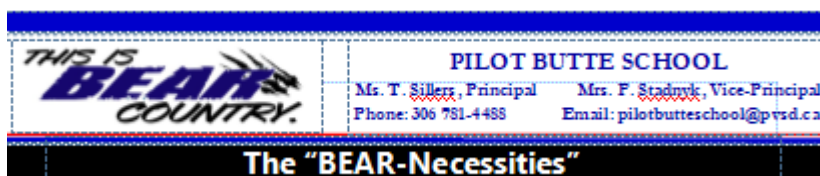

### Fun Recipes for Home-Made Art Materials!

#### Finger Paint

2 cups flour  
2 tsp salt  
2 and 1/2 cups cold water  
2 cups hot water

Mix the flour and salt.  
Add cold water. Beat  
until smooth and gradu-  
ally add hot water. Boil  
until clear, beat until  
smooth and add food  
coloring.

#### Modeling Goop

2 cups salt  
2/3 cup hot water  
1 cup cornstarch  
Add salt to water and heat 4-5 minutes.  
Remove from heat and add cornstarch,  
cold water. Stir until smooth, cook mix-  
ture until thick

#### Puff Paint

Mix two tablespoons of washable tem-  
pera paint and 1/3 cup of white glue. Add  
two cups of non-menthol shaving cream.  
Best used soon after mixing.

and shrub maintenance

Promotion of Habitat: bird baths, feeders and houses, native  
plant species to promote pollinators and support of insect and  
wildlife conservation.

Environmental Harm Reduction: rain barrels to collect for  
irrigation, creative planter containers, outdoor furniture, use of  
reclaimed materials (wood etc.), use of mulch to suppress

weeds and lower watering requirements.

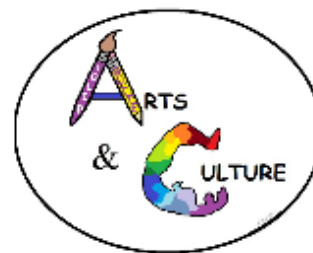

### School days are here again

A reminder for drivers to take extra care as excited kids are heading back to school. The speed limit is 30 km/hr in school zones. On rural roads: stop no closer than five metres (15 ft.) from the front or back of the bus. Do not pass the bus until you've checked for children and the bus driver

turns off the flashing red stop lamps and deactivates the stop arm.

For those 'newly minted' drivers excited to drive to high school, a friendly reminder that our Community Safety Officers patrol in the area as do members of the White Butte RCMP detachment; tickets can be expensive and result in lost points from your license.
