Saskatchewan has Municipal elections this fall as well as the Provincial election.



Provincial election will be held **Monday, October 26, 2020.**

Municipal elections will be held on **Monday, November 9, 2020**

**Municipal Advance Polls** will be Saturday, October 31, from 1 to 4 pm in the Council Chambers and Tuesday, November 2, from 5 to 8 pm in the Council Chambers.

There will be new processes and safety measures put in place to protect voters, election workers, candidates or candidate representatives at the polls.



# 25 Years—The Storm of 1995

**Saturday, August 26, 1995 4:45 pm**  
**State of Emergency Declared 5:45 pm**

25 years ago, Pilot Butte was hit with a “plow wind” and suffered millions of dollars in damages to homes, property, 2500 or so trees and vehicles. The clean up task was immense but with everyone working together, the town was almost restored to its former glory. Many trees were lost but many were replanted or nature lent a hand. 



Although the Back to School season feels a little bit different this year, remember that roads and streets will soon be busy with kids and buses.

- The speed limit in school zones is 30 km/h.
- Do not pass a school bus until you've checked for children and the bus driver turns off the flashing red stop lamps and deactivates the stop arm.
- Give the bus room – stop no less than 15 feet from the front or back of the bus.



He was predeceased by his father, William Hryhorash; mother Sophie (Joe) Fromski; wife Mavis; son-in-law Eric; brother Marion (Carol) Fromski; sister-in-law Alice Tyson; and brothers-in-law Sam Cheremkora and Harry Bannow. Don is survived by his daughter Cindy Zelmer; siblings Lila (William) Cherniawsky, Jeanette Cheremkora, Victor (Mildred) Fromski and Delmar (Marianne) Fromski; brother-in-law Jim Tyson; sister-in-law Edith Bannow; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Dad loved to help people and was always ready to lend a helping hand to the neighbours. He volunteered for VON, St. John Ambulance, and several nursing homes. Dad loved jokes, music, and to dance. He loved classic and unique cars and even owned a few. He loved animals, especially cats.

Dad was always better at wrecking things than fixing things. He loved going fishing with family and friends as well as gardening and putting around in the yard and garage.

He missed Mavis terribly after she died, and missed me (Cindy) and the cats when he moved into a nursing home due to health issues. His passing from a lung infection was unrelated to Covid-19.
