COVID-19 Protocols will be observed as per Saskatchewan Health Authority requirements.

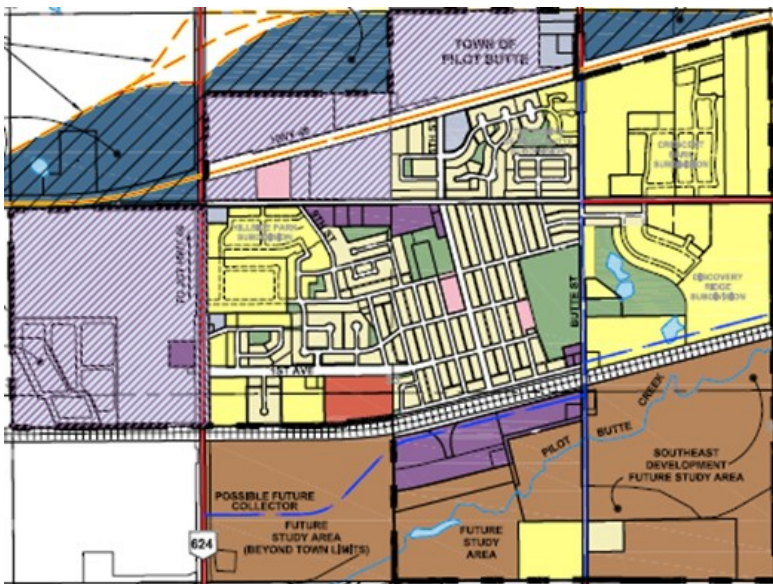

**The Town of Pilot Butte has initiated an Official Community Plan (OCP) and Zoning Bylaw (ZB) update project.**

An OCP is the municipality's vision for the future and outlines a timeframe for achieving that vision. It is a comprehensive policy document designed to guide the physical, environmental, economic, social, and cultural development of the Town and was last updated in 2014.

### What is a Zoning Bylaw (ZB)?

A planning document that implements the policies, objectives and goals set forth within the Town's Official Community Plan (OCP) while providing a legal way of managing land use and future development. The Zoning Bylaw (ZB) also outlines the day-to-day administration including processes for the development of land and applying for various permits.

The ZB controls the use of land in your community through regulations regarding:

- How land can be used;
- Where buildings and structures can be located;
- Development standards associated with specific uses;
- Site specific regulations such as lot sizes, setback distances, building heights, parking requirements, etc.

The Zoning Map designates a zoning district for every property within the Town. Each zoning district accommodates different types of development and outlines the specific development standards for that zoning district.



## The Council Connection

Council meetings are **Open to the Public**. Meetings are normally held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> **MONDAY** of each month. If a Statutory Holiday falls on a regularly scheduled Council meeting Monday, the Council meeting will be held on the Tuesday. Unscheduled Special Meetings are advertised in advance for public attendance.

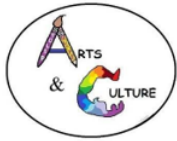

## **Wanted - Volunteers to join the Pilot Butte Arts & Culture Committee**

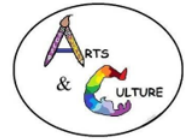
The committee meets approximately once a month to organize events such as the annual arts show, concert series, family board nights and various art classes.

## Brett Cross Medical Journey

As some of you may know, Brett was diagnosed with a brain tumor on July 9th, 2020.

He started having headaches about 2 years ago, which have progressively gotten worse until now. He went to see his family Dr. a couple of times, tried a couple different medications that he was given but didn't like the way they made him feel. From there he went back to his family Dr. and was referred to a neurologist, who then sent him for a CT Scan on July 9th, 2020. They discovered a benign brain tumor centrally located in his head. He was then referred to a couple different neurosurgeons and ultimately decided to go with Dr. Michael Cusimano out of St. Michael's Hospital in Toronto, On.

After consulting with Dr. Cusimano, Brett felt like this was the right move. He and his wife, Jessica will be travelling to Toronto sometime in the next 4-6 weeks, where he will have a very serious, all-day surgery to remove as much of the tumor as possible. He will then have to spend

some time in the ICU and possibly upwards of a month in the hospital/Toronto for recovery, depending on when he can fly again.

He will then have to travel back to Toronto or to Winnipeg in 3-6 months (depending on how he heals and how fast the tumor is growing) to have another procedure/treatment (Gamma Knife Radiation) done to try and "zap" the remaining bit of the tumor to stop it from growing.

With all of that comes the extra costs of travelling, meals, hotels, etc. all while not being able to work. Brett will have a long road ahead of him and there are still a lot of unknowns at this point.

Anyone who knows my brother, knows that he has the BIGGEST heart and would give the shirt off his back to a complete stranger. IF you are able to help out financially you can donate here. We also understand that not everyone is able to contribute financially and that's ok!!! Please keep Brett in your thoughts and prayers as he continues on this scary, unknown journey. Thanks in advance and please share.
