Improvements include any work on your property that required a building permit.

You can appeal your assessment until May 12, 2021. If you want to appeal your assessment, please fill out the "Notice of Appeal to the Board of Revision" that forms part of your assessment notice. Please include any relevant supporting material facts such as pictures or any documentation that may be of assistance to aid in the appeal process. Please

ensure that you include the \$75.00 filing fee and if your appeal is successful, the filing fee will be refunded.

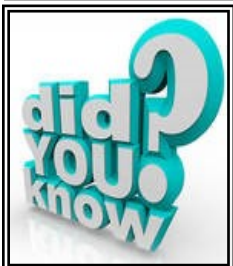

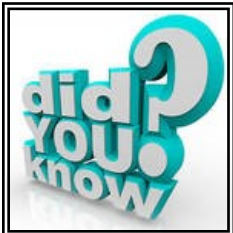
... **That Assessments have been mailed out!** 2021 is a revaluation year? This means the current assessed value on your land and home will be changing to reflect a base date as of January 1, 2019. All residents will receive an assessment notice in the mail with the new assessed value.



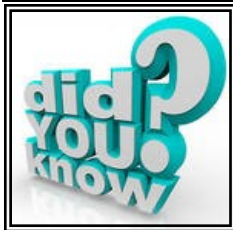
...that your new home may include the header or posts for a deck. This does not indicate that a deck was included with your home build. Your builder is aware whether your deck was included with the build of your home.

If your deck is not included with the permit for your new home, a Deck Permit must be submitted and approved prior to construction.

We appreciate our resident's compliance with our Zoning Bylaw.



... That if your garbage or recycling is not picked up, you can call or email the Town Office and we will call Loraas to come back and pick it up? It may not have been picked up for a number of reasons **however as long as you put your garbage out by 7 am**, it should get picked up! Loraas may not get to it that day but they usually do come back. They have GPS on their routes now that can pinpoint whose cart was or wasn't picked up!



... that the Town's Office Hours will be changing April 1, 2021.

**SEWAGE BLOCKAGE** - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Town Maintenance Director) if this condition is not met. A **maintenance man is on call after hours for emergencies** and is available by **calling 306-781-4547 Option 6**. Thank you.

The Town of Pilot Butte adopted:

**Bylaw 03-2021 A BYLAW RESPECTING THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE.**

ATV Registration to begin mid April and the following rules will apply:

- All ATV's operating within Town Limits must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte. Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum speed of 30km/hr.
- The Town recommends that residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from their place of residence.
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are NOT permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

## ATV Registration



### What You Need To Know.....

- ♦ All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- ♦ Golf Carts are NOT Permitted
- ♦ Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- ♦ The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- ♦ Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- ♦ Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- ♦ All Terrain Vehicle are NOT permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- ♦ Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- ♦ Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

## YARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

### Purpose of policy:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 14-2005.

### Scope of policy:

This policy is effective throughout the entire Town on residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.

### Inspections:

- Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- Untidy and Unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement or delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notification process stated in *Section 4: Notification*.
- Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in *Schedule A: Inspection Dates*, which are subject to change annually.
- Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.
- ***Inspections will be done on the following dates: June 15, July 20, August 17 and September 30.***

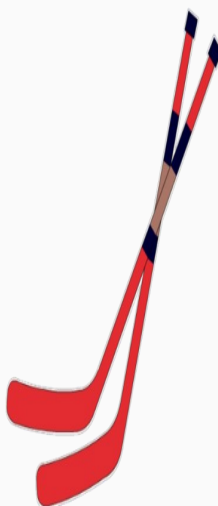

## Help us meet our sponsorship goal, and be a part of history by keeping youth baseball in our community!

Broncos Baseball is a branch of the White Butte Minor Ball Association that brings together youth aged 4-18 to form baseball teams with skill levels that range from recreational to competitive. We serve youth from Balgonie, Pilot Butte, White City and Emerald Park, as well as the immediate surrounding communities. In the upcoming 2021 season, and for the first time, Broncos Baseball plans to field a team in 18U AAA - the marquee division of youth baseball.

However, we have a major problem, and it is the focus of this sponsorship drive. In our community, the Balgonie Sports grounds houses our only 18U diamond. This diamond does not meet Baseball Sask guidelines and is lacking in safety measures which will force our AAA team to play its home games in Regina until a new diamond can be completed.

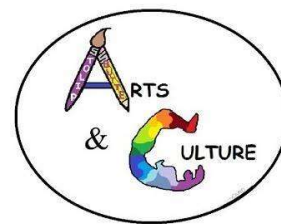

# Nicole's Preschool
