On individual properties, there can be slight increases or slight decreases. Properties that had improvements on their property in 2020, may see an increase in their assessment. Improvements include any work on your property that required a building permit.

If there is an error on your property report, please call the Town Office at 306-781-6250 or email us at townofpilotbutte@pilotbutte.ca and the town will review with you and/or forward onto S.A.M.A. for their review. You can appeal your assessment until May 12, 2021. If you want to appeal your assessment, please fill out the "Notice of Appeal to the Board of Revision" that forms part of your assessment notice. Please include any relevant supporting material facts such as pictures or any documentation that may be of assistance to aid in the appeal process. Please

ensure that you include the \$75.00 filing fee and if your appeal is successful, the filing fee will be refunded.

... <u>That Assessments have been mailed out!</u> 2021 is a revaluation year? This means the current assessed value on your land and home will be changing to reflect a base date as of January 1, 2019. All residents will receive an assessment notice in the mail with the new assessed value.



...that your new home may include the header or posts for a deck. This does not indicate that a deck was included with your home build. Your builder is aware whether your deck was included with the build of your home.

If your deck is not included with the permit for your new home, a Deck Permit must be submitted and approved prior to construction.







... That if your garbage or recycling is not picked up, you can call or email the Town Office and we will call Loraas to come back and pick it up? It may not have been picked up for a number of reasons *however as long as you put your garbage out by 7 am*, it should get picked up! Loraas may not get to it that day but they usually do come back. They have GPS on their routes now that can pinpoint whose cart was or wasn't picked up!



... that the Town's Office Hours will be changing April 1, 2021.

The Town of Pilot Butte adopted

Bylaw 03-2021 A BYLAW RESPECTING THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE.

ATV Registration to begin mid April and the following rules will apply:

- All ATV's operating within Town Limits must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
 Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum speed of 30km/hr.
- The Town recommends that residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from their place of residence.
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are NOT permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

What You Need To Know.....

- All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- Golf Carts are NOT Permitted
- Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicle are NOT permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.

YARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

Purpose of policy:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 14-2005.

Scope of policy:

This policy is effective throughout the entire Town on residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.

Inspections:

- Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- Untidy and Unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement or delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notification process stated in *Section 4: Notification*.
- Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in *Schedule A: Inspection Dates*, which are subject to change annually.
- Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.
- Inspections will be done on the following dates: June 15, July 20, August 17 and September 30.







ST. AGNES PARISH SCHOLARSHIP

Any grade 12 graduating student who is a member of St. Agnes Parish in Pilot Butte may apply for the \$800.00 scholarship being offered by the Parish. The scholarship will be awarded Sunday, June 13, 2021.

To apply for this scholarship:

- 1. You must have a first year application in to any post-secondary educational facility, and must be enrolled for at least half of the classes in the semester.
- 2. You must be a member of the St. Agnes Parish community.
- 3. The candidate must write a short personal essay. The main theme of this essay should be "How I express my Christian faith in both the local and global world."

There is no length requirement for this essay.

Do not include your name in the essay. For identification purposes, please submit your name on a cover page only. Your name will not be provided to the judging committee, as judging is done


