

# ORGANICS & COMPOSTING COLLECTION PROGRAM



Our new program is under way and we would like to remind all residents of the items that are accepted and the items that are **not**.

Wood and tree limbs have become an issue in the composting process, so we want to be more clear on these particular items. **NO construction material can be placed in the green cart – specifically, Lumber. NO tree limbs larger than 1’ thick or longer than 2 feet are to be placed in the green cart.**

With the new process, a grinder is used at one of the stages and it is not able to break down large pieces of wood.
