Private Swimming Pool Development Permit Checklist

- Please complete all requirements of the application, including this checklist.
- Ensure all information is clear, legible and precise.
- Plans must be in a clean and professional manner. Plans will be reviewed to ensure compliance with the Town of Pilot Butte "Private Swimming Pool Bylaw".
- Drawings stamped with "not for construction", "preliminary" or "for permit only" will not be accepted.
- Note: A private swimming pool permit is not required for pool depths under 600mm.

	The following components are required to be shown on the plans:
	Site plan: drawn to scale in metric. Indicate the size of the lot, all property lines, size and location of buildings or other structures, location of enclosure, pool
	location, size and volume of the pool (include zoning setbacks), easements,
	location of the heater and filter, and where the backwash water will drain.
	Pool construction details: all pool construction details must be submitted with appropriate professional seals for in-ground pools.
	3. Enclosure and walkway construction details: drawn to scale in metric. This shall
_	include a cross-section of the fence enclosing the pool, gate details, self-closing
	details, self-latching details, locking device details, and walkwaydetails.
	4. Deck or other structure plans (if applicable): if you are building a structure or
	over your pool (deck, covered pergola, etc.) a building permit may be required.

Private Swimming Pool or Outdoor Hot Tub – On-Site Inspection Requirements Town of Pilot Butte (Swimming Pool Bylaw No. 06-2019) Effective August 12, 2019

Please call Town Office at 306-781-3407 when items below are completed and ready for inspection.

The following is a list of safety requirements that must be met to comply with the Town of Pilot Butte swimming pool bylaw for private swimming pools with a depth at any point of 600 mm (24") or more.

Hot Tu	Ib: [Bylaws 8 (water supply) & 14 (safety devices) do not apply to hot tubs as long as the following are met]:
	Equipped with a cover that can support the weight of 77 kilograms. [Bylaw 4(a)(i)] Has a lockable device to prevent persons from entering the water. [Bylaw 4(a)(ii)] Cover is in place and is locked at all times when owner/occupant is not supervising its use [Bylaw 4(a)(iii)]
Water	Supply:
	Potable water supply connections require a plumbing permit and inspection by a Public Health Official from Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region (306-766-7705) to ensure that water in the pool system does not flow back into the municipal water supply and distribution system (i.e. use of an approved backflow preventer.) Contact the Town of Pilot Butte Water and Wastewater Department (306-537-8713) if you are uncertain about this requirement. [Bylaw 8]
Enclos	sure / Fence (capable of preventing unauthorized entry and kept in good repair):
	filled with water. [Bylaw 9(b)(i)]
	Height of enclosure must be at least 1.8 metres (6 ft.) , measured on the exterior "non-pool" side from the top of the enclosure to the nearest platform, deck or grade below. [Bylaw9(b)(ii)]
	Enclosure height of at least 1.5 meters is acceptable if the swimming pool is additionally protected by a mechanically locking protective cover tested and certified to meet or exceed American Society for Testing and Materials F1346-91 standards for pool safety and is installed as per manufacturer's instructions and to be kept in a close, locked position unless the pool is in use [Bylaw9(e)]
	No gaps or openings that exceed 20 mm (3/4") in size are allowed horizontally or vertically on the interior pool side, which is horizontally from one side of the gap or opening to the other side or
	the gap or opening. [Bylaw 9(b)(iii)] Any parallel horizontal structural members on the exterior "non-pool" side must be spaced so that the top of the highest horizontal structural member is 1100 mm (44") or more from the next lowest horizontal structural member. [Bylaw 1 0(b)(i)]
	Any vertical structural members on the exterior "non-pool" side must be spaced so that gaps and openings between members do not exceed 100 mm (4"). [Bylaw 10(b)(ii)]
	If diagonal structural members are used (allowed only on interior "pool-side"), then gaps between vertical members must not exceed 20 mm (3/4"). [Bylaw 1 0(b)(iii)]
	Chain link fence , if used for part or all of the enclosure, must not exceed 50 mm (1.95") in mesh size and the wire core must be at least 11 gauge. [Bylaw 1 0(c)]
	Above-ground pools with sides not less than 1.2 metres (4 ft.) in height (measured from the finished grade and any climbable fixture or feature on the exterior face of the pool wall to the top rail of the pool wall) only require that ladders or stairs providing access to the above-ground pool be enclosed and gated. [Bylaw 5(a)(i)] Pumps, heaters, filters, or other equipment serving the above ground pool must also be enclosed and must be located at least 1.2 metres (4 ft.) or more away from the top rail of the pool walls. [Bylaw 5(a)(iii)] Note that any other provincial building standard requirements for raised walkways, decks, stairs, etc. must comply with the currently adopted edition of the National Building Code of Canada and may require a building permit.

_	of the gap or opening to the other side of the gap or opening. [Bylaw 11(a)(ii)]	
Ц	Gate must swing in the direction of exit travel (swing away from the swimming pool.) [Bylaw	
_	11(a)(iii)]	
Ц	Self-closing device designed to return the gate to the closed position after each use is	
_	required. [Bylaw 11(a)(iv)(1)]	
Ц	Self-latching device designed to hold the gate in a closed position after each use is required.	
_	[Bylaw 11(a)(iv)(2)]	
	Locking device is required to prevent unauthorized entry. [Bylaw 11(a)(iv)(3)]	
Ш	Every gate must be anchored to fixed posts or secure structures on both the hinge & latch sides. [Bylaw 11(a)(v)]	
	Chain link fence, if used for the gate, must not exceed 50 mm (1.95") in mesh size and the	
	wire core must be at least 11 gauge. [Bylaws 10(c) & 11(d)]	
	Structural members on gates (horizontal, vertical or diagonal) must meet all Bylaw 10(b)	
	requirements noted under the "Enclosure" section on page 1 of this document. [Bylaw 11(e)]	
	requirements noted under the Englosure section on page 1 of this document. [Bylaw 11(e)]	
Securi	ing of Swimming Pool Area:	
	All entrances to the swimming pool area, including gates, windows and doors, must be	
	locked when the pool is not under competent supervision. [Bylaws 11(c) & 12(a)]	
	Although not a bylaw requirement, consider interior doors leading directly from the house to the	
	pool area have an elevated, child-proof lock or latch system controllable by an adult.	
Walkw		
	Walkway at least 750 mm (30") wide must surround the perimeter of the swimming pool and	
	be properly maintained. [Bylaw 13(a)]	
	Walkway must be placed so that it is no more than 1200 mm (47") below the top rim of an	
	above-ground swimming pool. [Bylaw 13(b)]	
Safaty	Devices (required in the pool area at all times and are easily accessible/visible):	
_	Reaching pole with a length that measures at least half the width of the pool. [Bylaw 14(a)(i)]	
	First aid kit. [Bylaw 14(a)(ii)]	
	Buoy attached to a rope with a length that measures at least the full width of the pool.	
_	[Bylaw 14(a)(iii)]	
П	Although not a bylaw requirement, consider additional pool safety devices, such as:	
_	pool covers and meshes,	
	□ pool alarms (triggered when doors and/or gates are opened),	
	pool signage with safety notices (e.g. no glass containers in the pool area, enter the	
	pool feet first, never swim unsupervised, first aid instructions, etc.)	
	 secured safety rope dividing the shallow end from the deep end, 	
	 access to a telephone and numbers for emergency calls. 	

Dlage	se note that no person shall place water in a swimming pool or permit water to remain in	
ı ıca	the swimming pool without an on-site inspection being conducted by the town.	
	To fill the pool without the proper approvals and inspection is illegal.
