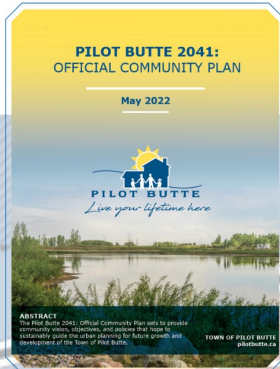

Yard Maintenance Policy



Purpose of Policy:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 14-2005.

Scope of Policy:

This Policy is effective throughout the entire Town on residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.

Inspections:

-  Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
-  Untidy and Unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
-  If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notifications process stated in Section 4: Notification
-  Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in Schedule A : Inspection Dates, which are subject to change annually.
-  Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.
-  Inspections will be done on the following dates: June 15, July 20, August 17 and September 30.

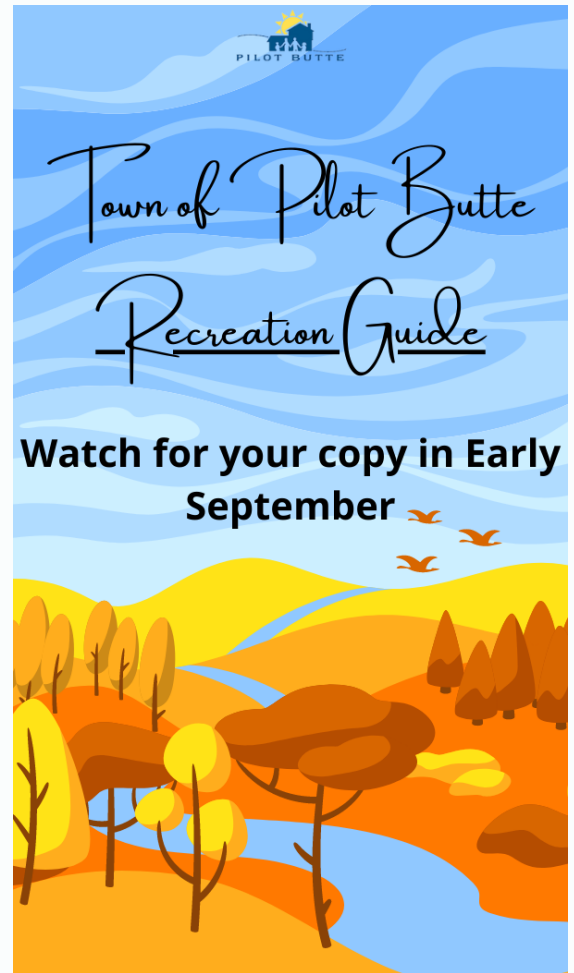

Parking Restrictions

The Town would like to remind residents that from October 31st to April 30th the 72 Hour parking restriction is in effect for Town boulevards.

Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard, please ensure that campers, boats, trailers, or any other items owned are not stored on the boulevard.

AT NO TIME may vehicles be parked for periods longer than 72 Hours on the pavement of any curbed street and may never be parked on the pavement of a street with no curb.

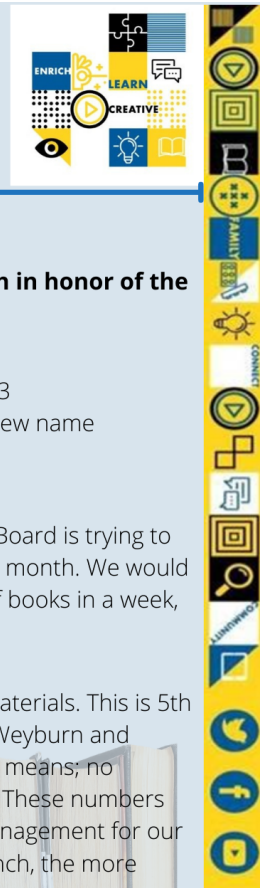

Did you know....

Pilot Butte Library patrons saved \$312,864 by using library materials. This is 5th highest in our Region of 47 branches, including the Cities of Weyburn and Estevan! There were 11,132 first time items checked out (this means, no renewals, or electronic services are included in this number). These numbers play a very important role in the material we receive from management for our patrons, as well as our open hours. The more use of our branch, the more popular books, movies, and video games we receive!

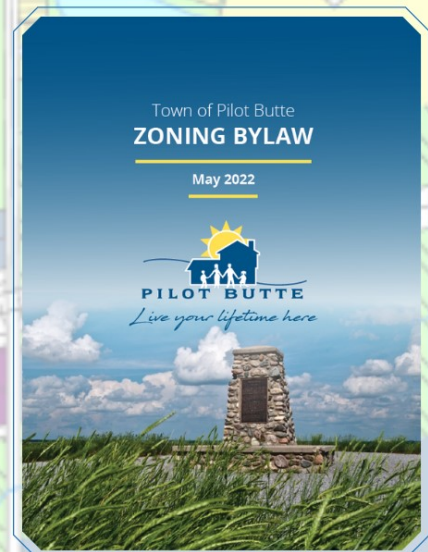

GROUP MESSAGING SYSTEM

The Town of Pilot Butte uses the Group West Broadcasting System to send out items of general interest. Examples of notices sent using this system include, but are not limited to; Town events, road closures, policy or procedure changes which affect residents and local emergency alerts. The Town does not use this system for private events or for lost animal notifications.

Residents can receive notifications through a phone call, email or both. Emailed messages often include links that direct Residents to the Town website for further information. For phone messages, the Town provides a guide on how to find the information on the website.

To register for the Group West Broadcasting System, you can use the E-Service Request function on the Town Website. (Under "category type" select: Administration and under "request type" select: SYNREVOICE/GROUP WEST.

Be sure to indicate in the request details how you want to receive your message; via email, phone call or both.

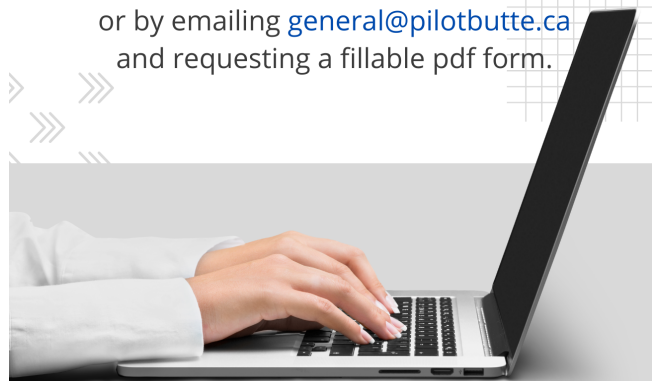

Hybrid Yoga Class

This class will combine chair and mat yoga.

Each class will include a warm up, a dynamic sequence of poses, and a mindful cool down.

Our dynamic sequence will begin with yoga poses seated on a chair. Each chair pose will be demonstrated with different levels of flexibility. This means people of all ages and fitness backgrounds can adapt each chair-based posture to suit their fitness needs and goals. Levels of flexibility help ensure postures are practiced safely and effectively on the chair.

While it might look a little different, the benefits of chair-based yoga are the same as mat-based postures. This class will use postures created by Lakshmi Voelker-Binder. Her method, known as LV chair yoga, is practiced all over the world and is used by the Mayo Clinic in its wellness programs.

After we work with chair-based postures, options will be given to transition these postures onto a mat. Participants will choose whether they continue on the chair or move onto their mat based on their own comfort level.

Gordon W. Bleackley

Gordon W. Bleackley, former Mayor and Council member of the Town of Pilot Butte (1982 to 1988), passed away in Brandon, Manitoba on June 21, 2022.

Gord mentioned in the Pilot Butte History Book that

"It was most interesting to watch and to deal with the increasing population/development explosion, the requirements for adequate and suitable infrastructure, recreation facilities, police and fire protection, yet still maintain the lowest tax mill rate possible . . . similar to walking a tight rope!"

He watched with interest the progress and numerous changes happening in the community. He was happy to see Pilot Butte grow and prosper.

Gord was a former R.C.M.P. member from 1953 to 1979. Gordon and his wife, Shirley retired to Brandon to be closer to family and friends in 1997. They still maintain contact with several friends in Pilot Butte and area.

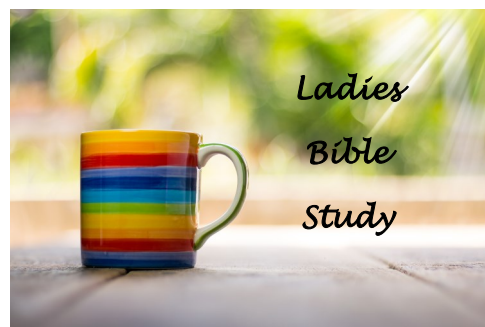

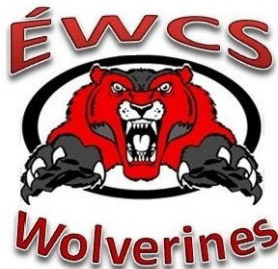
