





Parking Restrictions

The Town would like to remind residents that from October 31st to April 30th the 72 Hour parking restriction is in effect for Town boulevards.

Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard, please ensure that campers, boats, trailers, or any other items owned are not stored on the boulevard.

AT NO TIME may vehicles be parked for periods longer than 72 Hours on the pavement of any curbed street and may never be parked on the pavement of a street with no curb.



The PB Public Library and the Town of Pilot Butte are honoured and excited to have Tony Stevenson, and his wife Marcie McArthur Stevenson share their knowledge on the impact of residential schools on the lives of Indigenous children and families, and the legacy of these schools in Canada.

Their program is titled Legacy of Residential Schools Tour where they will discuss residential school experiences and feature a screening of the film We Were Children.

(Film deals with mature subject matter)

Tony is an Anishinaabe First Nation from Treaty 4 land. He attended the Qu'Appelle Indian Residential School at Lebret, Saskatchewan from Grade 5 to 12. Tony's experiences both professional and personal have given him the ability to be an advocate for residential school survivors. He wishes to educate communities on the history and truth of the residential school system in Canada. His goal is to expand the Legacy of Residential Schools Tour from Saskatchewan to reach across Canada.

A quote from Tony Stevenson, "With these presentations I hope to appeal to the genuine humanity of the hearts of the Canadians that want to learn and more importantly, understand, so that we can change the future by way of actions and not just words. I believe if you want to be called a Canadian, learning and owning the real history of the past is a mandatory requirement so it is never repeated!"







GRIFFIN DRAMA


