



SEWAGE BLOCKAGE - If you suspect you have a sewer blockage, the line **MUST be checked by the Town Maintenance Staff. Payment may be refused** (at the discretion of the Town Maintenance Director) if this condition is not met.

Maintenance staff is on call after hours for emergencies and are available by calling 306-781-4547 Option 6. Thank you.

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Winter parking restrictions are in place from November 1st to April 30th every year. There is a 72 hour restriction on parking on Town boulevards.

- The boulevard is the Town-owned land between the edge of the paved street and your property line.
- On streets with no curb, there is NO allowance for parking on the pavement at any time.
- On streets with no curb, the boulevard may be used for parking of vehicles in daily use. The 72 hour restriction doesn't mean that you drive your vehicle around the block and re-park it. It means that you cannot store vehicles on the boulevard during the winter months. The same thing applies to paved streets where there is a curb.
- On any street, where there is or is not a curb, the Town appreciates that vehicles will not be parked either on the boulevard or on the pavement when snowfall is imminent. When operators are cleaning the streets, particularly after heavy snowfall, that snow has to go somewhere, the boulevards serve that purpose.

The Town thanks all those residents who help us out by complying with the law. Please be assured that vehicles which are left on boulevards or on streets may be ticketed and /or towed.







The month of November found us staring up at the stars at preschool! We put on our space helmets and climbed aboard our imaginary rocket ship to blast off and explore the Solar System!


From stirring up a "solar system" in our Water Table, to making rocket ships, the preschoolers had a blast during the month of November exploring our space project and learning all about planets, and the great beyond.

"The planets play Ring Around the Rosie around the sun!"; "The sun is a star made of fire!"; "Gravity sucks you down to the Earth and did you know that the Big Red Dot on Jupiter is a giant storm that never goes away?" These were just a few of the cute quotes of the children as we learned about the topic. My favourite is when they learned that Pluto is no longer considered a planet but instead it is a Dwarf or "baby" planet.

At the Water Table the children enjoyed scooping up "alien" wiggle eyes with ladles and wrapping wooden blocks with foil to build a Space Station. We made constellations with star stickers and chalk and little toy astronauts in moon buggies scurried about in the Moon Sand table and "moon rocks"! We evenshone photos of the planets on the wall with our new solar system photo projector.

We also crashed tennis ball "meteors" into sand to make our own craters and made a Venus "volcano" with baking soda, vinegar, liquid soap and a pop bottle!
